Update:

- As of 19 May, Abdullah Kattineh has received a full scholarship funded by the Cambridge Trust and Corpus Christi College.
- Representatives of the CRSC will be meeting the Pro-Vice-Chancellor for Education and the Director of Development on 25 May.

Dear Graham Virgo,

It has recently come to light that a 19-year-old Syrian student, Abdullah Kattineh, has received an offer to study Natural Sciences at Cambridge. Abdullah is a friend of a current JCR President and former JCR Access Officer, whom he met at an International Chemistry Olympiad. At the Olympiad, Abdullah won a Bronze medal, while 'studying from a tiny screen with no access to electricity for 18 hours a day and living with the constant fear of losing his family and friends at the same time'. Currently, Abdullah's only hope of starting at Corpus in October is through crowdfunding the cost of tuition fees and living expenses.

Cambridge currently has no sustainable system of scholarships for students whose education has been interrupted by political and/or humanitarian reasons, and students like Abdullah now face huge financial barriers, after facing so many others. Given that Cambridge has the largest endowment of any university in Europe, we believe that this institution has the financial means to support such students.

In 2015, a group of academics from universities across the country wrote an <u>open letter</u> to university vice-chancellors, calling on them to each create 5 undergraduate and postgraduate scholarships and bursaries for students fleeing war and violence. <u>Over 50 universities across the UK</u> such as Oxford, SOAS and Warwick University offer scholarships and bursaries thereby promoting equal access to university education for these students. As of today, May 17th 2018, the creation of such scholarships for prospective Cambridge students <u>by the University</u> is yet to be seen.

As a world-class institution that prides itself on welcoming 'talented students from around the world' it is alarming that there is no adequate provision for <u>all</u> refugees or asylum-seeking students. In the words of Gurminder Bhambra of Sussex University, 'it's important that human rights to education beyond national boundaries are recognised.' Cambridge's efforts to increase access to the university for those from underrepresented groups should not just be limited to students from the UK.

So far, across the collegiate university, 32 J/MCRs have passed a motion endorsing the <u>Cambridge Refugee Scholarship Campaign (CRSC)</u> - a student group which launched in October 2017 in response to the devastating impact that the ongoing refugee crisis has had on the pursuit of education.

At CUSU Council in Lent Term, a motion was passed unanimously mandating CUSU to support CRSC's efforts to lobby the university to create scholarships for future refugee students to study at Cambridge. This is a testament to the fact that as a student body, we believe that all students have a right to access university-level education. We are confident that these scholarships would empower the future leaders of many conflict-ridden nations and help build the foundation for sustainable peace and justice around the world.

We, the undersigned call on Cambridge to:

- 1) Provide Abdullah with a full scholarship covering tuition and living costs for the duration of the Natural Sciences course
- 2) Set up 10 scholarships for refugees and students whose education is severely affected by political and/or humanitarian crisis, available every year from the 2019/20 academic year
- 3) Work in partnership with the Article 26 project, supported by the Helena Kennedy Foundation, to promote access to higher education for refugee students and those seeking asylum
- 4) Work in partnership with CARA (Council for At-Risk Academics) to engage with refugee academics
