## **CLUB TENNIS CHAMPIONSHIPS 2025-FINALS DAY 19 JULY**

Once again, the Club Tennis Championships will be organised online.

As last year, all draw sheets and results will be accessed and updated online.

Each event is included as a separate tab on the spreadsheet and will be updated regularly on receipt of results. There will also be a hard copy in the pavilion which Connor will update.

Match formats are as follows:

- All **Open** events consist of 3 tie break sets (to 7)
- All other events (O45, O60) consist of 2 tie break sets with a 10-point championship tie break as a deciding set.

**All finals** will be played on **19 July**. Matches will only be postponed to the Sunday in the case of extreme weather conditions.

- It is the responsibility of **ALL** players to contact opponents as soon as possible.
- When you have booked a court, please email Sue Hobden with the details so that we can identify it as a 'Championships' booking on ClubSpark. To be sure of getting a court, please contact Sue who can book more than a week in advance (edclubchamps@gmail.com)
- ALL results must be emailed to <a href="mailto:edclubchamps@gmail.com">edclubchamps@gmail.com</a> promptly so that the draw sheets can be updated in a timely manner. If possible, email your next opponents immediately to let them know (their contact details can be accessed online through the link above).
- If you have any planned holidays or absence of more than a week between now and finals day 19 July, it is imperative that you inform the committee and potential opponents at the beginning of the tournament. In case of dispute, the Committee's decision is final.
- If you know in advance that you have limited days of the week when you are available to play, please let your draw opponents know as soon as possible.
- Please contact the committee immediately if there is any issue such as injury, finding a date or difficulty in making contact.
- Matches can be played on any surface, but the finals will be played on the Astro courts.

Although the 'play by' dates often seem a long way off, please make every effort to get matches played as soon as possible, especially doubles as they always take longer to arrange.
