## **Supply List:**

**Stamps:** Your Biggest Fan Photopolymer Stamp Set

**Dies:** Sports Event Dies

Ink: Classic Stampin' Pad: Night of Navy, Crushed Curry

Paper: Cardstock: Crushed Curry, Basic White, Hey Sports Fan 12"

x 12" Designer Series Paper

**Tools:** Sponge Dauber, Paper Trimmer, Bone Folder, Mini Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine or Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, Silicone

**Embellishments:** Resin Stars

Adhesives: Stampin' Seal, Stampin' Seal +, Stampin' Dimensionals,

Multipurpose Liquid Glue,

- 1. Cut Crushed Curry Cardstock at 5 ½" x 8 ½". Score at 4 ¼". Burnish with Bone Folder along valley score (mountain or bump on the inside of the card). Orient in landscape.
- 2. Cut Evening Evergreen baseball diamond print from the Hey Sports Fan 12" x 12" Designer Series Paper at 4" x 5 1/4". Be sure the print is horizontal to accommodate landscape orientation of card! Adhere to the card front with Stampin' Seal, Stampin' Seal +, or Multipurpose Liquid Glue your choice!
- 3. Using the Sports Event Dies, cut out the Poppy Red string of mini tickets from the Poppy Red striped print from the Hey Sports Fan 12" x 12" DSP using the string of mini tickets die aligning up on the Poppy Red portion of a stripe. Adhere to the card front using Stampin' Seal, Stampin' Seal + or Multipurpose Liquid Glue starting from the lower left of the card front and angling towards the right.
- 4. Using the Sports Event Dies, cut out the Poppy Red and Night of Navy two part ticket from the Hey Sports Fan 12" x 12" DSP with the two part ticket die. I selected the Night of Navy two part ticket where the sentiment on the bottom ticket is "Let's Get Together & Celebrate". Adhere this one to the right side of the card leaning at a left angle with your favorite Stampin' Seal, Stampin' Seal +, or Multipurpose Liquid Glue. Adhere the Poppy Red two part ticket with Stampin' Dimensionals angled to the Right over the Night of Navy two part ticket, allowing the sentiment to be clearly seen.
- 5. Using the Sports Event Dies, cut out the Night of Navy banner with the sentiment "Yay" from the Hey Sports Fan 12" x 12" DSP using the banner die. Cut out the Banner flags from the Bumblebee and White Star print from the Hey Sports Fan 12" x 12" DSP using the flag die. Adhere the flag to the left side of the banner aligning the edges using Multipurpose Liquid Glue. Adhere to the upper left corner of the card front with Stampin' Dimensionals angled to the left just barely overlapping the Poppy Red two part ticket.
- 6. Using the Sports Event Dies, cut out the Bumblebee "Best Day Ever" ticket from the Hey Sports Fan 12" x 12" DSP. Adhere to the lower left of the card front using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 7. Using a scrap of Basic White, stamp the "Happy Birthday" image from the Your Biggest Fan Photopolymer Stamp Set. Using the Sports Fan dies, cut the single ticket by center the Happy Birthday sentiment in the center of the single ticket die. Stamp the star cluster image from the same set in the upper right and lower left corner of the ticket using Crushed Curry. Using a Sponge Dauber and Night of Navy Classic Stampin' Pad, distress the edges of the ticket. Adhere to the card front using Stampin' Dimensionals in the middle angled towards the right.

- 8. Embellish the card front with a large Bumblebee, Poppy Red and Night of Navy Resin Stars.
- 9. Cut Basic White card stock at 4" x 5 ¼'. Stamp the "Hope Your Day is a Grand Slam" sentiment from the Your Biggest Fan Photopolymer Stamp set using Night of Navy Classic Stampin' Pad. Stamp the cluster of stars with Crushed Curry Classic Stampin' Pad on one side of the sentiment and Poppy Red Classic Stampin' Pad on the other side of the sentiment. Adhere to the inside of the card using either Stampin' Seal, Stampin' Seal + or Multipurpose Liquid Glue your choice!
