Student Parking Passes

General Parking Rules & Expectations

All vehicles parked on Brother Rice's campus during the school day **must** display a valid Parking Pass. While driving on campus, students must comply with all rules found in the Student/Parent Handbook, as well as all applicable Michigan laws and regulations regardless of the time of day. Student parking is a privilege that may be revoked by the Dean of Student Formation for infractions of school policy, for part or all the school year, with no refund given.

Vehicles parked without a valid Parking Pass or parked in a *No Parking Zone* risk being towed at the owner's expense. Students must park in the assigned Student Parking lot. Do **NOT** park in the Staff lots, which include the front lot on Lahser, the lot facing St. Regis Church's main doors, and any spaces labeled "Staff" including those closest to the Gym Entrance (Door #13).

Parking Lot Safety

The speed limit on school property is 10 MPH and is strictly enforced. Driving in a reckless manner, speeding, or making excessive noise on school property is strictly prohibited. As outlined in the Student/Parent Handbook, students who violate these safety rules may receive multiple detentions, suspension of driving privileges, suspension from school, citations from local law enforcement and/or the requirement to take a remedial driver's education course at the student's expense.

Damage to automobiles on school property is the responsibility of the vehicle owner and should be covered by the owner's insurance policy. Brother Rice is not responsible for damage to vehicles or loss of personal property.

Parking Pass Eligibility & Availability

Due to continued enrollment growth and limited parking capacity, Parking Passes will be available **exclusively to licensed juniors and seniors**. Parking Passes will be sold on a **first-come, first-served** basis and may not be pre-purchased before obtaining a valid driver's license. **One Parking Pass will be allowed per family**. Availability is limited to approximately 260 student parking spaces on campus. Families are encouraged to consider alternative transportation options, including Brother Rice bus service, Birmingham Public Schools bus service (for eligible district residents), carpooling, or purchasing a parking pass for an eligible Marian sibling, if available.

Parking Passes will be distributed from the Dean's Office during lunch periods through the month of August and then from the Finance Office beginning September 1, 2026.

- To receive a Parking Pass, licensed student drivers in Grades 11 and 12 **must present their valid driver's license** (driving permits are not accepted).
- The licensed student driver **must also present their valid vehicle registration**, which shows the license plate number. Changes to the vehicle being driven must be reported to the Dean's Office.
