

About Everett Community Growers:

Everett Community Growers (ECG) is a community-based nonprofit organization working to build a more just and equitable environment through urban agriculture, youth development, policy advocacy and community engagement. ECG operates two community gardens and two urban farms, and conducts community engagement and advocacy activities centered in racial, economic, environmental and language justice. Our community gardens provide plots for personal food growing for over 40 Everett families, and our urban farms grow organic produce, most of which is distributed to the wider community via a retail operation, and some of which is donated to local families and food pantries.

Job Title: Farm Retail Coordinator Location: Everett, Massachusetts Classification: Nonexempt

Position Type: Part-time/Seasonal (April - November); average of 20 hours/week*

Pay Rate: \$19 - \$21 per hour (dependent upon experience and skills)

Position Summary:

The Farm Retail Coordinator works to increase access to fresh, healthy produce in our community by overseeing the day-to-day operations of our retail program, including farm stands and pre-ordered pick-ups, during the growing season. The Coordinator works to expand our impact through outreach to SNAP/Healthy Incentives Program (HIP), WIC, and Senior Farmers Market Coupon customers.

Essential Functions:

- Manages retail events including farm stands, pre-ordered pick-ups and additional retail events, with tasks including but not limited to: scheduling, tracking inventory of supplies, coordinating logistics of events (set-up and break- down), and management of the retail process.
- Maintains the quality of produce and upholds a clean, inviting appearance in the distribution area. Oversees and tracks the distribution of all produce from harvests to produce sales and donations.
- Ensures compliance with SNAP/HIP, WIC, and Seniors Farmers Market rules and regulations during all retail events.
- Creates and tracks weekly harvest and sales reports.
- Manages Point of Sales system (Square, TotilPay) during retail events.
- Develops and manages an inventory of outreach materials for retail events, including flyers and content for email newsletters, Facebook, and Instagram, among others.
- Assembles multilingual pamphlets that include produce availability, recipes, vegetable storage tips, farm updates, WIC and SNAP materials, and volunteer opportunities.



- Provides training about the retail process to Youth Crew and assists with the supervision of Youth Crew during retail events.
- Works closely with ECG staff on projects related to retail, as needed.
- Manages customer feedback surveys and communicates with the ECG team.
- Regular attendance is an essential function of this position.

Other Duties and Responsibilities:

- Participates in food production (planting, harvesting, weeding, and watering) with the Farm Manager, Youth Coordinator, Youth Crew, and volunteers, as needed.
- Attends regular ECG staff meetings.
- Acts as an engaged and collaborative member of the ECG team.

Required Education/Certification and Experience:

 Familiarity with Massachusetts food systems, with a focus on SNAP/HIP, WIC, and Senior Farmers Market programs, is preferred. A willingness to learn and cultivate this knowledge is also valued.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

Required:

- Excellent customer service and communications skills, both verbal and written.
- Full season commitment required.
- Ability to work both independently and with a team.
- Computer savvy and high proficiency with a spectrum of technological products and web-based software, including Canva and Google Suite.
- Profound passion for urban agriculture and an unwavering dedication to furthering the causes of health equity, food justice, racial justice, and language justice.
- Optimism and positivity, a desire to work efficiently and collaboratively, attention to detail, an ability to make quick decisions, and a desire to be a part of a diverse team.

Preferred:

- An understanding of farm retail models, strongly preferred.
- Multilingual proficiency (English and Spanish, Portuguese, or Haitian Creole), strongly preferred.
- Experience with graphic design, preferred.
- Everett residence or demonstrated involvement in the Everett community, strongly preferred.



Environment and Demands:

- Willingness to work flexible hours including early mornings, late evenings, and weekends. Our workday may not end at the same time every day.
- Must have the capability to repeatedly lift and move weight that ranges from 30 to 50 pounds.
- Ability and desire to continuously perform manual labor in all outdoor weather conditions.

Travel required/not required:

Must be able to travel within Everett frequently.

*This position is seasonal for 2024, with the potential to evolve into a full-time, year-round role, contingent upon the organization's available resources. If additional resources for this position become available for this position, discussions regarding increased hours and compensation may take place later in the year.
