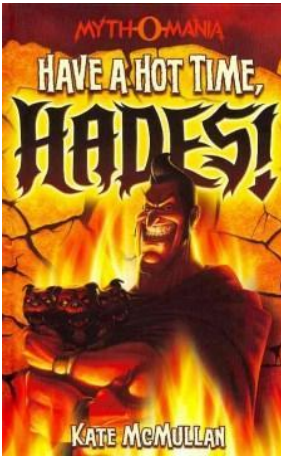

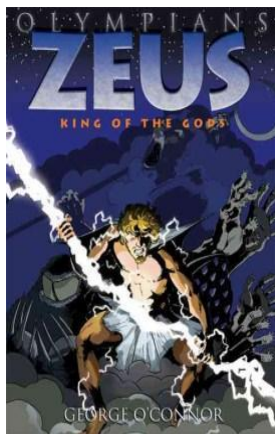
In this story with a modern twist, Hades tells his own version of how he became King of the Underworld and Zeus became King of the Gods.

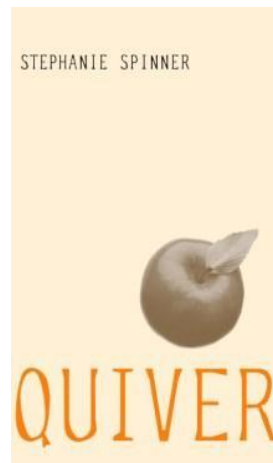

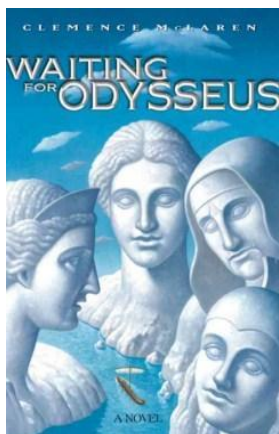
A series of graphic novels that provide fictionalized retellings of the origin myths of the Greek gods and goddesses.

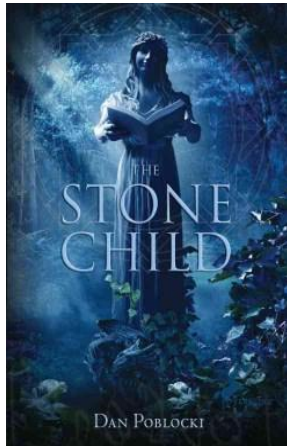

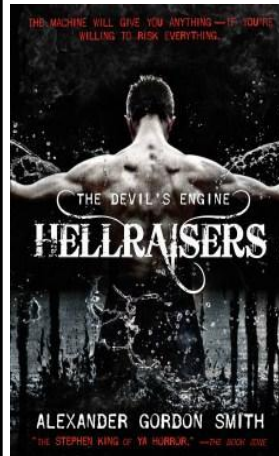
The Stone Child

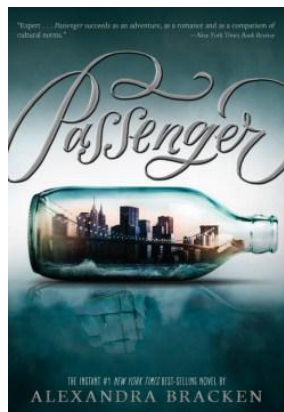
A Song For Ella Grey

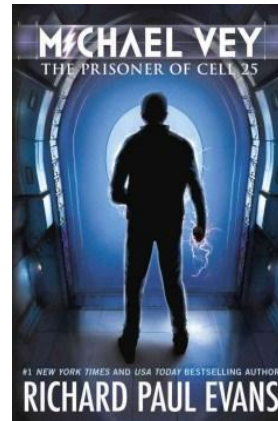
Masterminds

 A group of teens discovers they were cloned from the DNA of some of the greatest criminal masterminds in history for a sociological experiment.



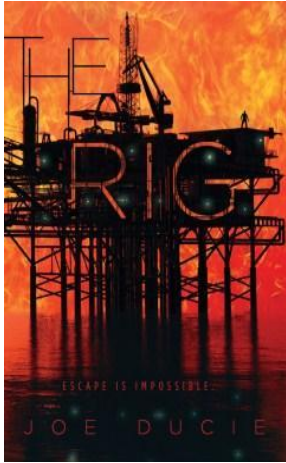
Hellraisers

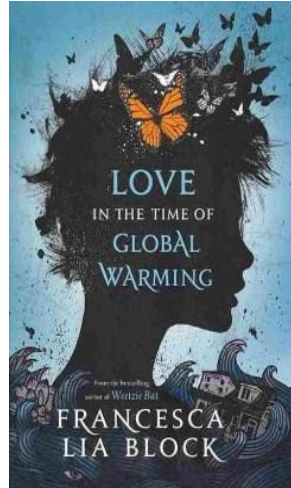


Michael Vey: The Prisoner of Cell 25

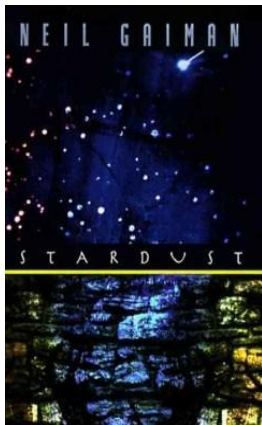
The Rig

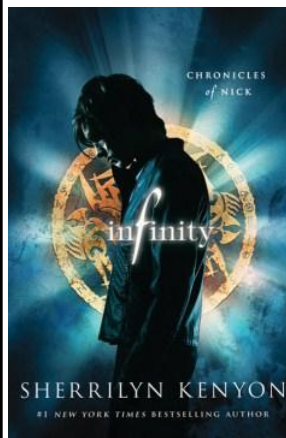
Love In The Time of Global Warming

By Neil Gaiman

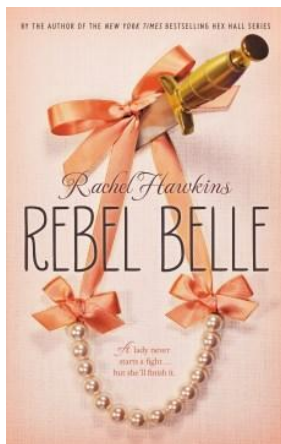
