AUDITION PROCEDURES/TIMELINE

- NAFME Membership must be current through the event date.
- **Online Audition Window: Monday, September 28 through Wednesday, November 18 11:59PM**
- **Postmark Deadline: All forms and fees to event chair (Heather Calame): Monday, November 16th**
- **Adjudication Requirement:** Per CCS policy, all submitting directors must be available to assist with online adjudication **November 21st-25th**
- Directors will receive the final audition results to distribute to families during **the first week of December**

AUDITION PROCEDURE AND FEE INFORMATION

Auditions are completed through audio recordings and uploaded to Festival Scores.

The event code is **LXW89CV**

No digital alterations of recordings will be accepted. No reverb, cuts (other than between excerpts), or other edits should be made.

This year, audition fees and participation fees may either be mailed to the chair like in the past, or paid through Festival Scores. Payments done through Festival Scores are subject to an online payment fee. [Click this link for an online payment fee calculator.](#) It is also possible for directors to give students access to upload their own recordings and pay their own audition fees at the discretion of their director. Please weigh all of the options carefully and use the system that works best for your school.

Audition fee: **\$5.00** per student

Participation fee (if accepted): **\$60.00** per student.

One school or director check per honor ensemble for any students not paid through Festival Scores. No parent checks accepted.

AUDITION RESULTS

Directors will receive a complete list of audition results by the first week of December. Accepted students should confirm their schedules as they are expected to punctually attend all rehearsals and the performance. Sports and all other extra curricular activities are not acceptable reasons for absence or tardiness to rehearsals or performance. **Students that are no-shows are still responsible for all fees.**

All music will be sent out in early December. Teachers are expected to work on Honor Ensemble music with students and monitor their progress prior to the first rehearsal. Please encourage all your students to audition. The experience of preparing an audition is highly rewarding and can spark your students' focus and ambition.
