



OKAY SO YOU GET THE POINT, THEY'RE LITERALLY ALWAYS TOGETHER. In the VBS Main Story after Chapter 14 [The breakup era], Akito and Toya were apart from each other to the point even other people who weren't really close to them thought it was out of the ordinary to see both of them alone. AND WHAT DOES THIS EXACTLY MEAN??? They were literally always together even people who weren't exactly close to them could distinguish that the other one is missing during the BAD DOGS break-up era.

2. VBS CHAPTER 14.

This chapter is quite famous in the akitoya fandom because of the "akitoya divorce era" or basically for its angst potential or smth like that.

But then let's have an overview of why it happened or something

Akito was shitting on the Vivids because he thought they had a half-assed resolve since Kohane mentioned that she'd never done events aside from singing in music class. After doing that, Toya had a moment of self - reflection and realized how half-assed his resolve was. He didn't know much about surpassing RAD WEEKEND. How he knew so little about the dream he was following with Akito, and how he basically used the dream they were following to escape from classical music.

TLDR; Toya thought Akito deserved better than him. How a person like Akito who was so passionate about his dream doesn't deserve a person like Toya who has a half-assed resolve.

Toya even states during Chapter 13 how Akito and the Vivids are similar because they will dedicate their lives to surpassing their dream and face it head-on, while he's the only one who isn't like that. That it's only him that's different

What Toya meant by "our music means nothing" he only means that Akito needs a new partner, one who doesn't have a half-assed resolve. Toya was willing to give up the dream just for Akito. Toya thought he wasn't being serious about RAD WEEKEND. Toya means that if Akito were to work with another person, it would actually have meaning. It's just THEIR songs specifically that have no meaning. Toya thinks that he's using street music as an escape from classical music which is why he made that proposition to stop singing with Akito. He doesn't feel worthy of singing beside Akito.

Toya even states around Chapter 15 that he and Akito should've been separated a long time ago.

During the whole confrontation(?) scene between Akito and Toya during Chapter 14, you can completely hear Akito's voice trembling. Akito thought that Toya was doing it against his own will because of his father being forcing Toya back to classical music but it was actually Toya quitting that kind of dream in general I think.

I believe that VBS Chapter 14 was a result of miscommunication and it was a misunderstanding. It was understandable of Akito to punch Toya's face cause the way Toya worded things made it sound kind of harsh. In this situation, no one here is to be blamed or is at fault. Having a misunderstanding over a miscommunication is completely normal, and what's better is that THEY MADE UP.

And if you pay attention to Toya's facial expressions throughout the chapters or something it feels as if he doesn't wanna be apart from Akito. He has that sad look all over his face. He has that same frown, his eyes look so contemplated, and his poses are almost the same as if he's deep in thought whether he should separate from Akito or not. I feel like Toya really doesn't want to break it with Akito, he really appreciates Akito for his passions but because Toya feels he's not passionate like Akito about their goal of surpassing RAD WEEKEND, he decides

it would be better if Akito found another partner who is as passionate as him, who knows what they're doing.



And even after the disagreement between the both of them, you can clearly see his facial expression becomes gloomier or something



You can clearly see the sadness and regret in his eyes, but Toya thinks it's better this way if they weren't together in the first place. :(



As for Akito, you can clearly tell how hurt he was by Toya's words as during Chapter 14, his voice was shaking. And the aftermath of it, An even noticed that his ego is kinda gone.



Wasn't Akito the same person who told Toya to never show his face ever again and punched him? Why does he have that look on his face? IT'S BECAUSE AKITO OBVIOUSLY TREASURED TOYA A LOT. We can obviously see how Toya affected Akito's life by the way he reacts to Toya's proposal of "I'm not going to be performing with you anymore." [we can even hear how his voice is breaking]

he just looks so miserable after he and toya went their separate ways. [as if they actually broke up or something]

An even had Kohane go to Kamiyama [she studies in Kamikou btw] during school hours just so they could tackle about how much Akito means to Toya







Throughout the confrontation[?] Toya yet again has a troubled and contemplated look on his face, for someone who has no "special reason" for that you're looking kind of gloomy.. DID YOU OR DID YOU NOT ENJOY DOING THAT WHOLE PROCLAMATION OF

"i'm not gonna sing with you anymore, akito"
[spoiler alert: he certainly didn't otherwise he wouldn't have that stupid pathetic look on his face]

When Kohane brought up the fact that Toya looked like he was having so much fun back when he was singing with Akito. His expression changed into a surprised one and said something like "Is that so?... I see" An made a remark of how he didn't notice, and then afterwards said about how she can barely tell what his expression is like because it is barely noticeable / it barely changes, but whenever Toya is with Akito, An can tell how he is feeling. An can see how Toya is enjoying himself around Akito.

What does that imply? TL;DR: Toya is a really stoic person [he has autism] and his facial expressions barely change which makes it really hard for other people to recognize how he is feeling, but when he is with Akito, people could already tell how he is enjoying himself.

characters have said how it is hard to distinguish how Toya feels but Akito is one of the people who can easily tell what he is feeling. I remember there was this one area conversation within Akito and Toya where they were at the mall and Akito notices that something is wrong and so he asks Toya if something happened, Toya dismisses but Akito says that he had a scowl on his face so it wasn't really that convincing.

TL;DR — Akito can see right through Toya and distinguish what he feels despite Toya being described as a stoic

person

Continuing on with Chapter 16,

An and Kohane failed to persuade Toya in Kamiyama, but An comes up with a plan to convince them to get together again or something like that.

Meanwhile with Akito, he finally discovers the sekai and like after Len introduces him to MEIKO and all that stuff, Len goes "oh you're Akito of BAD DOGS right? And you've got a partner named Toya too!" Akito just goes "He isn't my partner!" And says things like that him and Touya aren't affiliated with each other anymore, "we have nothing to do with each other"

The setting changes to WEEKEND Garage where Toya enters and bids farewell to Ken or something like that — probably related to Toya giving up his dream to perform street music or smth like that and by that, the chapter ends there.

Okay but like WHY IS EVERYONE GIVING THEM PEP TALKS LIKE BOOHOO YOU'RE SAD THAT THEY BROKE UP??? GET A NEW FAN FAVORITE THEN ACCEPT THAT THEY JUST DID THAT IT'S THEIR DECISIONNNN. okay but being for real if they remained like that the akitoya fandom would no longer be real it will be full of angs- sorry. But if they did remain like that I bet you my whole life that it will be just them just thinking of each other and reminiscing the memories they had with each other. Toya would probably go "man akito was so cool and i'm probably just in the way of his dream." IT'S LIKE your classical highschool breakup and they'll never move on from each other or something like that. OKAY BUT VIVID BAD SQUAD WOULD'VE NEVER FORMED SO THERE'S THAT TOO.



CHAPTER 17 [summary]

The first half of this chapter starts with the virtual singers giving Akito the pep talk. Len asks if he and Toya fought. Akito

replies with "not really like that. But I swear that guy didn't think of me as a friend" and Len makes a

statement about how he doesn't know the whole story of them but Akito looks really sad because he has that angry pathetic look on his face. And Len understands how he feels



so he shares about his experiences with his singing partner, Rin, they share a lot of memories but yet they also fight from time-to-time.



Len makes a statement about how fighting with the person you're closest to is really lonely. Akito replies with "It sure is..." THIS BASICALLY IMPLIES THAT AKITO IS CLOSEST TO TOYA HELP LIKE MF IS CLOSER TO HIS MALE [genderfluid] BEST FRIEND THAN

HIS OWN SISTER????



[okay just so you know they actually don't say this in the dialogue, this is just my (very failed) attempt at being funny pls forgive me in advance]

Akito then goes like "I don't get how he just went "oh I'm sorry Akito but our songs have meaning lol!!" all of a sudden like wtf touya i thought you were my homie" then MEIKO just thinks "omg wtf why is this gay bitch so fucking stupid...teenagers this days istg" then she says smth like "okay you know what you stupid bitch, let's make something special for you" and she places oolong tea in some kind of whisky glass and hands it to Akito, then Akito goes "yo wtf i can't drink im a minor" and then MEIKO goes "OH MY GOD JUST FUCKING TASTE IT YOU STUPID BITCH" and then Akito tastes it and goes "oh this is oolong tea. WHY THE HELL IS IT IN A GLASS MEANT FOR WHISKY????" and MEIKO just goes "You see some things are not what they actually appear as, like that precious friend of yours.. Are you 100% sure that he actually meant what he said?" and Akito mutters to himself about how Toya isn't exactly the type to make jokes so he was overthinking what he said [he didn't get over it help] and he realized that he's kind of fucked up and he needs to make things right with Toya, and then he gets a call from Ken. Ken informs Akito about Toya and how he came to the cafe to bid farewell, Akito tells Ken to keep him on the line and thanks the three virtual singers for giving him advice.

The point of view switches to Ken, + the other three members of VBS [Kohane, An, and Toya]. Toya apologizes to Kohane for making her worry so much about him, Toya also thanks the Vivids for helping him come to a decision. Touya tells them to not inform Akito because he doesn't want to disappoint him. Toya informs Ken that he stopped

singing under BAD DOGS, and he says how much BAD DOGS meant to him and was very important to him. Ken jokes about how Akito will be coming here to complain about this and that [implying that Akito will probably never get over the fact over the breakup] Touya really cares for Akito that he tells Ken to please take care of Akito. Touya believes that Akito surpassing is something he is able to do, despite all the obstacles and such. This basically means that no matter the obstacles Akito will go through in his dream, Touya will always be there to support Akito. Ken says how Akito is basically the stubborn type — no matter what happens to him, he wouldn't break, and he tells Touya how he's similar to Akito to which Toya denies. Touya states that he isn't at all similar to Akito because he thinks he's using RAD WEEKEND as an escapism from his history with classical music.

And the chapter basically ends right there.

The setting in the street sekai is basically the Virtual Singers helping Akito realize that he's got to make things right with Toya. Why is that? No matter how much Akito says that he and Touya have nothing to do with each other or aren't partners anymore, they know deep down that he cares about Touya a lot and Touya matters to him. Which is why everyone was making the effort to share the stories to make them realize and such like how Kohane in Chapter 16 was sharing her experience with An and how hearing her sing made her heart beat [\approx], Len in this Chapter sharing his experience with Rin and how they share a lot of memories singing together but they still have disagreements once in a while. MEIKO gave him a realization that some things are not what they actually are.

TLDR; Everyone is making the effort to help them both because no matter how much they deny it, they still deeply care for each other, that's why they're sharing their stories relating to their problem.

With the WEEKEND GARAGE Gang, Toya shows how much he cares for Akito, the way he tells everyone in the cafe not to inform anyone of his decision because he doesn't want to disappoint Akito. The way he tells Ken to take care of him even if they're not partners anymore and apologize to Ken if Akito comes to his cafe if he comes there complaining about Toya constantly [even if it was a joke]. Touya is still looking out for him. The way he denies that he is similar to Akito because he feels very inferior compared to him because to Toya, Akito's a really admirable person in some way cause like the way Ken describes Akito, he's the type of guy that no matter what comes to him, he won't give up and will strive to work harder [Its also not a good thing, COLOPALE MAKE THIS GUY STOP OVERWORKING HIMSELF OR IM KILLING MYSELF] because Akito is really passionate about this dream, and Toya will always be there to support him whether they're partners or not. [he's literally the #1 akito defender] And the way he

literally gives up his dream cause he doesn't feel worthy pursuing that dream beside Akito due to his background with classical music. Cause Akito knows what he's doing because it's been his dream as a kid, and Touya is very new to this thing.

Tldr; The second half of this story is basically Toya rambling about Akito and how he's some cool person, and how Toya himself is nothing compared to him. Toya shows how much he cares about Akito.

CHAPTER 18 OVERVIEW

The chapter mostly takes in the setting of WEEKEND GARAGE. But it starts with a flashback of Little Toya and their background of classical music. How Harumichi practically didn't allow Toya to do anything and forced him to play classical music everyday, even if his fingers were hurting. There was a point where Little Toya asked his mom "Mom why is my dad an asshole" JOKE HE DIDN'T ASK THAT [obviously but his dad is definitely an asshole] but he asked his mother why he wasn't allowed to hang out and play with his friends: (and like he's been spending his childhood life all day on playing the violin and piano, and the flashback ends there. Toya says that because of that experience, there was a point where he had grown to hate music itself. And to be petty, he quit piano and violin but it didn't matter what it was as long as he could oppose classical music or something. He kept coming to WEEKEND GARAGE and started playing any music other than classical to rebel against his father, and that was a very childish reason to do so. And then, Akito came in and suddenly changed his life. He saw Toya performing in the alleyway and they told Toya that he was an interesting type and asked if they could partner up for a while, Akito introduced Toya to stuff relating to street music and such. Akito taught Touya about all this new dream, he certainly taught Touya how fun music could be.



Akito was his first friend.

Touya noticed how Akito is definitely going after the dream of surpassing RAD WEEKEND, and he thinks if he remains by Akito's side, he won't be able to or that he is slowing him down. Touya thinks of himself as half-hearted, he thinks that Akito doesn't deserve a partner like him, that he deserves a partner like Kohane or An because they're serious about surpassing RAD WEEKEND.
