Brice Frasure called the HVST meeting to order promptly at 530p. Welcomed and allowed each attendee to introduce themselves and their current associations. Previous HVST meeting minutes were reviewed with no additions or corrections.

The HVST goal is to also reconnect our community, that is divided by US33 and Hocking River, to improve transportation opportunities, infrastructure, safety, economic development, quality of life by placing a multi-use bike trail within our community and surrounding areas. Create opportunities for those who chose not to drive or cannot drive, gain accessibility to work, stores, health care, etc.

Currently high school and middle school students currently walk across the SR328 bridge over US33. Creating an excessive exposure to vehicular traffic.

Phase One proposed route, funded by the original \$950,000.00 TAP grant, from Aqueduct Park, East Front Street to SR328 & Maysville Williams intersection and middle school. Phase Two, funded by the additional \$\$1.5M TAP grant to connect high school and possibly Nelsonville Hock-Hocking Adena Trail.

Lisa Frasure and Ron Mash of D & R Studio LLC, are coordinating numerous aspects of production of a video showing transportation obstacles to students, local community and visiting tourist in the City of Logan and Hocking County. Historians, high school students, active bicyclists and the disadvantaged will be providing real life issues and areas of particular interests. Videoing will take place March 4 & March 18, 2025 from 430p to 6pm at the Hocking County Health Department. Participants will tell their personal stories of issues and examples of transportation difficulties.
