

IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING SWCC CLASSES 2025-2026

- Students MUST meet deadlines
- Eligibility based on Iowa Statewide Assessment of Student Progress proficiency
- Complete mandatory orientation
- Students are responsible for their own transportation
- Students must follow SWCC's calendar - students may have their college class when the high school is not in session
- Grades for SWCC classes are recorded on both the high school and the college transcript
- Students that withdraw from a class receive a failing grade on their HS transcript and a "W" on their college transcript
- Books are on LOAN and must be returned IMMEDIATELY upon completion of the class
- Students will be billed full cost of lost and/or damaged books
- Students have 15 hours of free tutoring available and 24 hour tech support
- CCHS students fall under all SWCC policies including academic suspension for low grades and student conduct violations related to plagiarism
- Failing a college course while in HS may have implications for future financial aid
- College courses taken during HS begin a student's college transcript
- Students that withdraw or fail a college class must receive administrative approval to take additional college coursework
- HS staff do NOT have access to student's college grades or attendance
- Every effort will be made to fill the sections offered at the high school before enrolling students into sections on the SWCC campus
- **9th & 10th Grade students taking online SWCC courses will be assigned a block in Mrs. Arnold's room - attendance is required!**
