Total Percentage Calculation:

Each category contributes 10% to the total grade. Therefore, if a student scores:

- 5 points in all categories: $(10 \text{ categories} \times 10\% = 100\%)$
- 4 points in all categories: $(10 \text{ categories} \times 8\% = 80\%)$
- 3 points in all categories: $(10 \text{ categories} \times 6\% = 60\%)$
- 2 points in all categories: $(10 \text{ categories} \times 4\% = 40\%)$
- 1 point in all categories: $(10 \text{ categories} \times 2\% = 20\%)$

This breakdown ensures that each aspect of the exercise is weighted equally in assessing the student's understanding and application of verb tenses and grammar rules. Adjustments may be made based on specific grading policies or emphasis on certain skills within each category.
