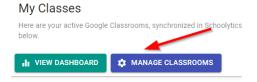
Overview: The free version of the Schoolytics Dashboard for Google Classroom allows you to <u>connect 10 Google Classrooms</u> to view a dashboard with a lot of analytics as well as reports for your Google Classroom. <u>What can I do with a free Schoolytics teacher account?</u> (There are some paid features that also include curriculum content and assignments located in their library.)

Get started:

<u>Visit their website</u> and log in with your Google account to get started for free! (The free version gives us a lot of tools for free!)



Click the Manage Classrooms to add your Classrooms to the dashboard:

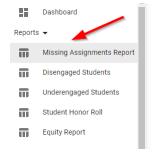


View Reports and schedule reports in the Dashboard:

When you open the dashboard, you can change your views at the top by selecting dates, groups, classes. (You can create groups within the product to view reports on that group of students.) (For those of you that have used Google's Data Studio, it has a look and feel like of this product.)



Pick your reports on the left:



Once you select the report, you can view it or click on the bell or 3-drips to save or schedule a report to be emailed to you.



For teachers: #exclude Assignments from Schoolytics:

Exclude any assignment and its submissions from your Schoolytics data by using the hashtag #exclude in the instructions. An assignment with this tag will not show up on any Schoolytics dashboards or be included in the calculation of any metrics.
