ISASP Testing: The Middle School administered the ISASP Test a few weeks ago. We have got all students completed and tests submitted. Students are tested in 3 areas: Math, Reading, and Language Arts/Writing. 5th and 8th grade students are also tested in the area of Science. Results are anticipated to be back in a couple more weeks. We are always excited to get the results back to see all the growth that students are showcasing. When results are back we will report out how our students did.
