



## Women's Golf Section Application Form for the 2026 Championship

This year will be the twentieth official Police Sport UK Women's Golf Championship. The event will take place between **10<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> May at Rudding Park GC.** [Golf at Rudding Park, Harrogate](#)

Accommodation for the event has been reserved at Rudding Park Hotel and includes unlimited use of the Repton 6-hole course, use of the on-site Indoor Swimming Pool, Bucket shower & Juniper log sauna for some relaxation after the golf.

The closing date for entries is **1st March 2026.**

Registration will be between 1000 and 1200 on **Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> May 2026** in the clubhouse. Tee times are reserved for the practice rounds from 1220 to 1440, playing in three and four balls on the Championship course.

The Championship itself consists of a 36-hole stroke play competition comprising 18 holes medal round on **Monday 11<sup>th</sup> May** and 18 holes medal round on **Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> May** on the Championship Course for both rounds. There will be a scratch championship, as well as concurrent handicap competitions divided into three categories consisting of handicap indices which will be decided after the closing date for entries and will ensure there is a similar number of entries in each handicap category.

The players with the top six gross scores and those with the top eight net scores will qualify for the teams for the PSUK representative matches in 2027 against the Army (scratch), United Kingdom Armed Forces UKAF (scratch) and Royal Navy (handicap). The team captain will have 2 captain's picks for the scratch matches.

All entrants are required to have a current World Handicap System handicap and to be a member of a golf club. Caddies and trolley pullers are not permitted to attend the Championships and players may not be accompanied by any other person during their round. Spectators and guests are welcome to attend with players as long as they don't interfere with play.

The Pro shop has pull trolleys for hire at £5 per round and electric trolleys at £16 per round which can be reserved on a first come-first served basis, bookable in advance with the Pro shop on **01423 871350**. Golf buggies are £40 and will only be permitted to be used in the Championship by a player having an appropriate Medical Certificate.

The Championships are intended to be as inclusive as possible. Full details of the qualification are available from the Vice Chair Pam Mace or a member of the committee. Those women eligible to play are serving police officers, police staff, cadets and special constables and retired police staff and retired police officers. Retired entrants must be in receipt of a police pension or police staff pension.

All qualifying players for the representative matches must be a current member of the Force Sports and Social Association either where they serve, served or where they reside.

The basic package includes two nights Bed and Breakfast, two evening meals, buffet on Tuesday, and all three rounds of golf, however, lunch on Monday is not included.

The AGM for the Women's PSUK golf section will take place on Monday evening prior to dinner being served and all entrants are encouraged to attend.

Any competitors planning to arrive the day before or looking to extend their stay by an extra night, can arrange accommodation direct with the venue.

There are several packages available.

- 1: Full package for a single room = **£556.00**
- 2: Two persons sharing a twin or double room (each person pays) - **£446.00**
- 3: Price for non-golfers to share a twin or double room (incl meals) - **£236.00**
- 4: Price for golfer not staying in the hotel - **£286.00**

The breakdown for these figures is:

### Single Room

- Entry Fee to PSUK event £30.00  
*(This covers the costs of organising the event such as prizes, printing, engraving etc.)*
- Bed and breakfast for a single room - £270 per person for 2 nights
- BBQ at the Clubhouse - £20 per person
- Three course dinner at Rudding House - £46
- Buffet during presentation - £10
- Golf - £180 for three rounds on the Hawtree course

### Sharing Room

- Entry Fee to PSUK event £30.00
- Bed and breakfast for a double-occupied room - £160 per person for 2 nights
- BBQ at the Clubhouse - £20 per person
- Three course dinner at Rudding House - £46
- Buffet during presentation - £10
- Golf - £180 for three rounds on the Hawtree course

There is no reduction in Green Fees if you do not play the practice round.

For those intending to travel by air, the nearest airport is **Leeds Bradford Airport**. Collection may be available Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> May and on Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> May and drop offs after 5pm on Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> May 2026
