Important Writing Hours Information:

- Students cannot sign up for more than 1 session (25 mins OR 50 mins) per week with each instructor. A 50-minute appointment = two 25-minute slots back-to-back
- Students must contact the instructor if they need to cancel sessions out of respect for the instructor's time and access for other students.
- Prompt arrival is important. Extensions of the sessions at the discretion of the instructor.
- Students should have Google Docs links of their assignment prompts/guidelines and drafts of their papers prepared before the sessions.
- If there are no available times, students should contact the instructor for possibilities.
