Open in Prayer, Welcome & Introductions

Review of Life Group Guidelines

Hook Question:

How do you usually react when you feel misunderstood and unappreciated?

Background of tonight’ story:

The apostle Paul writes to the people of GOD in the church of Corinth. He gives advice and instructions on important questions relating to faith and Christian life. He mentions in particular the need for unity and diversity regarding special gifts given by the Spirit of GOD. Let us see what vivid examples Paul is using to make this issue of unity and diversity clear and understandable.

Tell the Story: This week’s Bible passage is found in **1 Cor. 12:12-27**

Rebuild the Story

Read the Story out loud (look for additions or omissions)

Questions:

- Do you think that diversity of gifts is compatible with the concept of unity? Why or why not?
- What are some of the ways you are fully aware that GOD has specifically gifted you to bless the Body of CHRIST/HIS Church?
- Are there any parts of the body you have a hard time appreciating and how can you ask GOD to soften your heart to be more accepting?
- What can you do with your spiritual gifts to be a contributor, rather than a consumer in your group?
