### **Baby Ads**

A Cleveland tradition! Senior parents may choose to purchase a commemorative "baby ad" featuring a photo of their child. Traditionally, these messages include one or two photos of the senior as a baby along with a congratulatory message.

**The deadline for baby ads is the Friday before Spring Break (March 21).** Ads without payment will not be printed.

## **My senior photos are ready, now what do I do?**

1. Name your photo file with the student's legal name First, last.
2. Fill out the provided Google form with the information required including the student's quote and preferred name if desired. **Attach your student's photo in the designated section.**
3. Submit the form and then wait to confirm your photo was received via a confirmation list that will be sent out in early February. \*If your photo is **Not** included please reach out to us via email at asorensen@pps.net

**SUBMIT BY DECEMBER 20, 2025. Failure to meet this deadline can result in your photo not being included in the Cleveland 2025-2026 Legend.**

- **Portraits and Quotes Guidelines**

Nearly any "high-resolution" shot is fine. Med to high quality .jpgs are our most commonly submitted formats. Photos will be in a 2:3 ratio.

- Portraits should present your senior in a positive and appropriate manner. Please adhere to Cleveland's official dress code and avoid hats, caps, masks, hand signals, face paint, slogans and insignias on apparel, and photo distortion.
- Additionally, seniors may include an appropriate quote no longer than 25 words in length to be printed below their portrait. This is optional.
- "The Legend" reserves the right to refuse any portrait or quote it deems inappropriate for publication.
- We will create a list and a proof page with your senior portrait and seniors will have an opportunity to confirm that their photo will be in the yearbook. This will take place in February, and it will be communicated in eNews, Trivory and student school media.
- Rename files to students' legal name

## Other Information/FAQ

### Deadline for Ordering Books

We order a finite number of books from our publisher. We usually sell out, so the earlier you order your book the better.

Please note: while we usually have a few extra copies on hand at distribution, we can not guarantee books to anyone who has not ordered before the book is delivered.

### Distribution

"The Legend" is distributed in late May/early June. Distribution typically begins on a Friday, with seniors-ONLY picking up books on the first day. The rest of the students may pick up their books beginning on the next school day. Stay tuned when and where book are distributed. You will be required to have your ID to pick up a book, and you may not pick up a book for a friend. You can pick one up for a sibling.

### Unclaimed Yearbooks

Any copies of "The Legend" that remain unclaimed by the end of December (approximately 7 months after distribution) are considered "unclaimed" and made available to the public. Please pick up your yearbook promptly!
