

“We Won!” - Nazbol909 Delivers Primary Victory Speech in Minneapolis, Superior - Official Transcript

Nazbol909 will walk on stage in Minneapolis, Superior, waving to a large crowd of cheering supporters. The Senator had decided to spend the night prior in quiet, peaceful isolation, relishing her primary victory all by herself. Now, she comes out before the masses, flashing a smile as she arrives at the podium to begin her address.

We are prepared to inspire Superians with our bold, progressive platform, and I am confident voters will deliver the change we deserve on election day by choosing me as their Governor. I understand the challenges we face, and I am equipped to handle these challenges and bring positive change for working people. Be it a corrupt, dysfunctional state government, the climate crisis destroying our planet, or the scourge of income inequality, my campaign is all about addressing the issues weighing down on our communities and people.

Our state is suffering, and I am running because Superians are crying out for us to move away from the politics of the past. The corrupt Comped administration has failed the everyday Superian, and we need a reset of our state’s politics to change the game and rewrite the rules to work for the average person. Right now the system is rigged in favor of corrupt politicians, wealthy donors, and big corporations. As Governor I will shut out big money donors, instead giving every Superian a \$100 democracy voucher to donate to the candidate or candidates of their choice every election cycle, flushing big money down the drain and out of our state’s politics. This is how we give regular people a true say in democracy, and it’s how we combat the corruption and unresponsiveness of our state government. This is a simple, yet bold

policy solution to revive our state's democracy, and these vouchers will signal the end of the failed, corrupt politics which have led us to our current state of distress.

Speaking of states of distress, as Governor I will be laser-focused on combating the climate catastrophe set to have dire consequences for the planet and our state. I will enact a Green New Deal for Superior as Governor, investing tens of billions in green energy, public transit, and transforming our state's economy for the better. We need to substantially increase the use of renewable energy sources in our state, and I also support investment in nuclear energy as part of our transition away from fossil fuels. I also stress public transit as part of my plan, as I believe providing well-funded, available, and convenient public transit is key for moving our state away from broken car culture and towards reducing our gas consumption. Finally, my Green New Deal would reorient our state's economy to work for all. My plan would create millions of well-paying jobs through investments in green infrastructure, ensuring no Superian will be forced into unemployment if they do not wish to be in that situation. My plan also includes a carbon tax, with revenue from the tax being committed to my plan for a basic income, allowing for our fight against Climate Change to also help fight poverty in our state. Let's take action on Climate Change, Superior, and make our state a national leader in green energy, public transit, and building a human-centered economy.

And I believe that it is our urgent task as a state to build a human-centered economy, setting the scales right so that our state's economy may work for all. Millions of Superians are trapped in poverty, and our state must work urgently to put cash in people's hands. That is why I will pass a \$650 monthly basic income for those making under \$30,000 a year as Governor. This will alleviate poverty for millions, and would inject cash right into our local economies, jumpstarting growth and economic prosperity in Superior. I also support a universal child benefit of \$1,000 every year to parents for each child they have. Child poverty is unacceptable, and this simple benefit would provide parents the money they need to provide the resources and care their children deserve. We must also tackle housing scarcity in our state. Minneapolis has actually provided an amazing framework for what we need to do on the level of the state government, with the city's [Minneapolis2040](#) plan giving us a blueprint for how we can get rid of restrictive zoning laws and use a combination of public and private development to eliminate housing scarcity all across Superior, bringing down rents and providing truly affordable housing for everyday Superians. Let's build an economy which works for all of us, and as Governor I will make creating an equitable Superior my mission.

Once again, I would like to thank all of my supporters for my primary victory. I am fighting for the change we all deserve, Superior, and I know we will find victory in the general election just as we did in the primary. We are facing many crises, including corrupt leadership, the man-made disaster of Climate Change, and the inequity of our state's economy forcing low-income people into unjust living conditions. Let's turn the page on the politics and system which have failed us, and let's elect a Governor who will work for every Superiorian in office. We are going to win, and my inauguration will be a watershed moment for our state, marking the beginning of a new, prosperous era for Superior. Thank you, and as always, trans rights."
