  - Drafts may be posted as attached files, or as links to shared Google Documents
3. All authors read the whole group's pieces and compose at least 200 words of feedback for each author.
4. Combine all feedback into a single document (separated by subheadings for each author/piece), and post that Workshop Review on this forum.
5. Reviews are due by 11:59pm, Friday June 2nd
