

MCS Adult Education Virtual Program

“Let’s finish what we started and earn that diploma!”

What is it?

- Mason County Schools has established an adult education virtual program in accordance with [Kentucky Revised Statute 158.100](#)

Who can apply to attend?

- Any adult 21 or older currently living in Mason, Lewis, Fleming, Robertson, Nicholas, Bracken, Adams, or Brown County. *(Any former Mason County High School or Maysville High School dropout 21+ regardless of their residence can apply)*
- The adult must previously have dropped out of any high school but earned at least 16 credits or more at the time of dropout.

How do you earn the diploma?

- You complete the Mason County High School graduation requirements as of the 2022-2023 school year
 - 24 Credits = 4 English, 4 Math, 3 Science, 3 Social Studies, 1 PE/Health, 1 Visual/Performing Arts, & 8 Electives
- *Reminder: You must already have 16 credits or more to be accepted into the virtual high school so most of these credits will already be covered.*

How and where would I perform the work? Would I get help as needed?

- Each student in the virtual high school would be assigned required classes through the Mason County Schools Edmentum Online Program.
- The student would perform the work at their own pace and on their own schedule.
- Mason County Schools will provide a facilitator to monitor and communicate student progress.

How do I sign up? Any other requirements on my part?

- To register go to www.masoncoschools.com click Online Registration- New Student and complete the required documentation.
- For assistance with the registration or questions about the adult education program, you can call Mason County Student Services (606-564-7755) and ask for Angie Black (Community Education Director).
- Requirement: *Non-former Mason County students will need to submit an official transcript for their previous high school.*
- Requirement: *Students will need access to reliable, high-speed internet and a computer at home.*
