Funds raised by Christian evangelical organizations for projects in West Bank settlements (in thousands of dollars)

- These figures are based both on 990 forms submitted by these organizations in the United States and on reports published in the media about major one-time projects (i.e. John Hagee Ministries' sports complex in Ariel and JH Ranch leadership center in Ariel).
- In almost every case, no financial reports had yet been submitted for 2017. Based on the assumption that trends of recent years would continue in 2017, we concluded that the total for the 10-year period could reach as high as \$65 million.
- It is possible that some of the funds raised by these organizations come from Jewish philanthropists, but their reports contain no breakdown of the sources of funding. What is known is that they focus their fundraising efforts on evangelicals.
