
## **Infinite Campus - Multi Post Grades**

Infinite Campus has added the ability to post all of your grades at once instead of going to each


section and posting!


Multi-Post Grades: Step 1



- Select the Term, Section(s), and Task(s) to which grades will be posted (destination) in the Post to Filters.
- Indicate if grades being posted should Overwrite Existing Grades that have already been posted. (If you choose to Overwrite Existing Grades, you will get a screen telling you what grades got changed)
- Select which Sections to post grades from (source).
- Select the Term and Task to post grades from.
  - The Term and Task is where you have created your assignments (where they will receive their final (transcripted) grade.)
  - The Task should always be Semester since that is where you should be entering assignments
- Click Next to review grades prior to posting.
