

WileyPLUS + Canvas | Integration Setup Guide

Canvas Instructors or Administrators can follow this guide to install new WileyPLUS through the Canvas App Center.

To install WileyPLUS in a Canvas course or account go to Settings > Apps > View App Center. Search for 'wileyplus' then click the WileyPLUS tile.

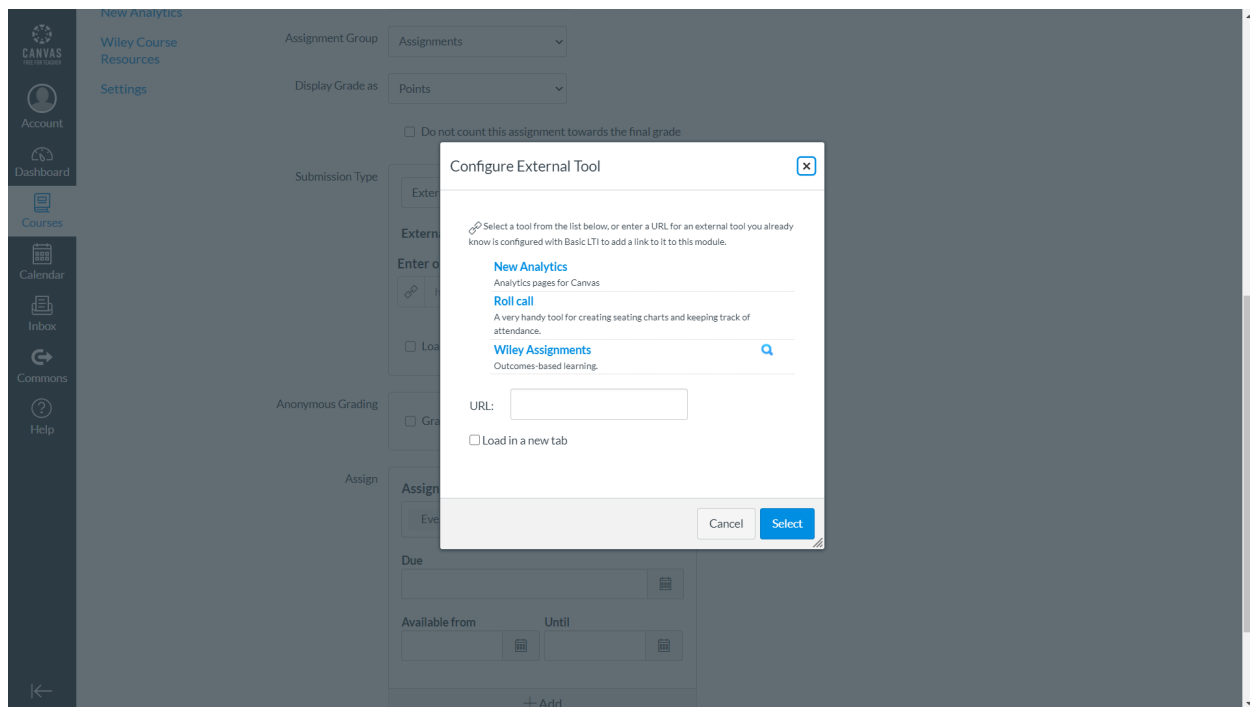
