<h2>Common Mistakes (with Fixes)</h2>  
<div class="box">  
<span style="color:var(--red);">She don't like pizza, does she?</span>  
<span style="color:var(--green);">→ She doesn't like pizza, does she?</span><br>  
<span style="color:var(--red);">You is coming, aren't you?</span>  
<span style="color:var(--green);">→ You are coming, aren't you?</span><br>  
<span style="color:var(--red);">They doesn't know, do they?</span>  
<span style="color:var(--green);">→ They don't know, do they?</span>

<h2>Tips Box: How to Identify Tags Fast</h2>  
<div class="box" style="background:var(--navy);color:var(--white);">  
<ul>  
<li>Check the verb: is there an auxiliary (be/have/can/will)?</li>  
<li>Switch polarity: positive sentence → negative tag.</li>  
<li>Use the subject pronoun in the tag, not the full noun.</li>  
<li>Double-check for “aren't I?” with “I am.”</li>  
<li>Let's = “shall we?”</li>  
</ul>
