The New American Scholarship is open to individuals who:
A.) have arrived in the United States within the last four years **and** are high-school seniors planning to attend an accredited university or college in Indiana as a full-or part-time student; or B.) individuals who have arrived in the United States within the last four years **and** are enrolled in and completing at least six credit hours per semester or quarter at an accredited Indiana college or university.

Candidates must demonstrate: 1.) character; 2.) financial need; 3.) scholastic achievement. Men and women of any religious affiliation may apply.

Complete this application, sign and submit with the following:

Essay – Scholarship is awarded to candidates who demonstrate character, financial need and scholastic achievement. Submit a typed, double-spaced essay, at least one page, explaining how you meet the eligibility requirements.

References – Ask two individuals to write letters of recommendation for you. You may ask teachers, employers, clergy, personal mentors, etc. (no relatives or significant others) . *Submit both letters with this application.*

Transcript – Submit an official school transcript with your application.

Financial Documentation – Attach prior year’s W-2 tax form to verify financial need.

Photograph – Include a wallet-sized photo with your name on the back.
