Once a lowly bastard daughter from an affair between her mother and a dragon of the clan Hailscale, Beirani has since been unshackled from a loveless and doomed life and flourished in the 20th Regiment as a highly respected and skilled Healer. She is the beloved and cherished Unified of Commander Frozurne and a respected member of the clan Burning Floe, who are wholly unaware of her sire's heritage.

Following a betrayal of her regiment in 3013, Beirani was briefly pulled from duty, both due to her injuries and Frozurne's own concerns about her safety in the 20th. However, she, along with the rest of the clan, were able to make him see sense, and she has since resumed duty as of 3016, much to the delight of the rest of her regiment.

Personality

Quiet, reserved and full of maternal affection towards those around her, Beirani is an embodiment of warmth, which is ironic since she is a dragon of a pure Ice lineage on both sides. She is good with logic, pragmatic thinking and bartering, and is someone dependable who can remain level-headed even in the most dire of straits, a skill she has built up after years of serving in the military. This level-headedness in the face of stress is what makes her such a skilled and irreplaceable Healer in the 20th. She is a welcoming and warm presence that puts many at ease, and with her gentle voice, impartial kindness and deep well of empathy, it is no wonder that her regiment and the clan she unified into are so fond of her. She has been given a rare privilege among dragons who unify into clans, and it isn't one she takes for granted.

As a mother, Beirani is the nurturer to Frozurne's protector, and is a loving and quiet presence, even to her more... *problematic* offspring. While not afraid to scold or allow discipline if necessary, she has always had faith in her children and loved them with all her heart, something her own mother denied her back then. She will not repeat such mistakes.

On-duty, Beirani takes on a more strict demeanor, and is not above being stern to dragons much bigger than her when they're being stubborn about their injuries. She's still her gentle self, almost motherly, but it's still a surprise when she manages to scold massive, powerful and intimidating soldiers into staying still and remaining at-ease so she can heal them. You *will* stay on the cot and let her inspect and patch up your wounds. No argument.

History

CW: Abuse, implied assault/harassment

Childhood

Beirani was hatched from a rich Ice family seeking to become a clan, the result of a one-night stand between her mother, Guard Froseri, and Guard Kazkabar, a young Ice dragon from Cla Hailscale. Froseri was paid to keep the fling and Beirani away from the clan and to cover the early expenses to ensure her pregnancy was as comfortable as possible, and her parents forced her to have the Heritage Substitution spell done

early on in the pregnancy, erasing everything except the snow spots Beirani inherited from her sire while giving her some of the features of Froseri's new Unified, Fluricus.

That turned out to be to Beirani's detriment, as her mother greatly resented Kazkabar and what he did, the bitterness from her broken dreams festering into hatred. Unable to take it out on the sire who had broken her heart, she took it all out on Beirani, and encouraged Fluricus and their future clutches to do the same. Beirani was less than a servant, nothing more than a punching bag and a tool. However, they were willing to send her to the temple, not wanting their "mistake" to be "more useless than she already was".

The temple was Beirani's escape and she flourished academically, even though she was still bullied by her siblings as well as those around her. One of her main bullies was an older clan boy named Rimos, who looked down on her for her clanless status, but that was put to a stop by the intervention of Frozurne and Amateris, Rimos's brother and sister.

Beirani and Amateris hit it off well, but she found Frozurne to be quite handsome under his serious and seemingly unflappable facade, even if he was distant from her for a time. Despite his seemingly rough and stern demeanor, she had a feeling he was kinder than he let on, but was forbidden from pursuing a relationship with him at the time. Froseri and Fluricus wanted to hand her off to a clan under Frostspear specifically, no one else, and Burning Floe's mixed heritage was a turn-off. However, Beirani did overhear them considering mixed clans as a "second-to-last option" should none of the other clans take the bait.

Adulthood

When she graduated in 2953, Beirani was quick to enlist in the military despite her family's insistence that she join the guard instead, wanting to get away from them as much as possible. Her training was brutal but she endured, and was placed in the 20th, where she was relieved to find Frozurne and Amateris, who were officially soldiers there. While she was not a fighter, Beirani's magical aptitude and ability to keep calm in the face of stress and chaos caught the attention of the Commander at the time, and

she became a Healer in the 20th Regiment following her mandatory service, having found a purpose in helping others and calming them down during the stresses of war.

CW implied attempted sexual assault/harassment

Around this time, her parents started shoving her at other Ice families and clans, putting Beirani in a lot of dangerous situations. Luckily, her Aqua ice was considered undesirable due to a possible mixed heritage, but that didn't stop some of the men she was shoved at from not taking "no" for an answer, and they continued to hound her outside of those failed offers. Beirani was very miserable, but was forced to grin and bear it, and was even found in public spaces, leading to her becoming more anxious and withdrawn.

One of these attempts caught the attention of Kazkabar, who stepped in out of the blue to save Beirani from one of her suitors. She noticed that their markings were similar, but she didn't think anything of it, assuming that it was a coincidence. She politely thanked Kazkabar and went on her way, not realizing that she had just come face to face with her sire, thinking him to just be one of the more noble guards who had less corrupt intentions. She also didn't pick up on the fact that Froseri had shoved her at every ice clan but Hailscale, not because of risk of inbreeding, but because if Beirani did end up in Hailscale, her bastard status would be revealed and everything would fall apart. All she knew was that her family, especially her dam, wanted her gone, and that they didn't care about how it happened, just that it *should*.

Betrothal To Frozurne

In 2959, when Beirani was 30, her family eventually (and begrudgingly) settled for a unity with Burning Floe, finally submitting to just getting rid of her in general over being picky about bloodline purity. Ullras and Hestina were luckily observant enough to gather that things were darker than they seemed, and agreed to talk things out, leaving Frozurne and Beirani alone together.

While Beirani was aware of Frozurne's feelings of pity towards her, she didn't let that get her down, and eventually learned of his kinder, gentler side when he defended her

from Rimos, and he learned of her quick wits, grit but ultimately kind and well-meaning nature when she got between the two brothers and managed to stand her ground against the cruel older dragon. After coming to an agreement, Frozurne agreed to the unity for her sake, and she was soon moved to the clan estate and away from her abusive family. She figured it would at least be an amicable marriage, and didn't expect Frozurne to be obligated to fall for her, just as he wasn't forcing her to fall for him. But alas, she fell for him and his awkward but genuine charm and kindness, and to her surprise, he was gentle with her in a way she had not expected, and true closeness formed between them. Turns out, Amateris had clocked him for being interested in her since their temple days, but he had not tried to make a move until now.

Breaking The Chains

CW kidnapping, abuse

One day, Beirani went out for a walk without Frozurne and was snatched up by her family, aided by a past suitor who had conflict with Frozurne. Imprisoned in her home and unable to leave, she was dragged back into the life she wanted to leave behind, but her brief time with Burning Floe had given her something she had never had before: hope. She had gotten a taste of freedom and the feeling of being genuinely cared for, and this allowed Beirani to hold on, and hope that she would get away this time, standing up to her mother, step-father and siblings despite the verbal and physical abuse they subjected her to. They eventually tied her up in their shed, willing to let her starve and wither in darkness, and their connection to the guard would allow them to get away with it.

Luckily, Frozurne eventually learned of Beirani's whereabouts from Kazkabar, who had seen one of his subordinates help her parents snatch her up, and he and some of his clanmates stormed the place with the intent of getting her back. Froseri and Fluricus initially refused, but Frozurne alone had the elemental and physical power to overpower Fluricus, and eventually, with the help of Ullras and Amateris, Beirani's family was strongarmed into letting Beirani go and were arrested for kidnapping and attempted murder, and Frozurne took Beirani back to the estate where she was fed and looked after by Healers. She was placed under the clan's protection, and her unity with Frozurne was made absolute, which Beirani was more than happy to oblige with.

She was finally free and could be with the dragon she loved, and could finally move on from her pain and suffering surrounded by dragons who cared about her and wanted the best for her.

Their unity was held under a cloudless, starry night sky, with the oath being delivered and agreed to without hesitation. The two danced (many say that Beirani had way less left paws than her Unified), and the two drank and talked until it was time for them to head home to consummate their marriage.

Motherhood

Seeing as the red bow did not become undone, it was no surprise to the clan when two eggs were laid after their Unity. While still young, Beirani was excited at the prospect of being a mother despite Frozurne's constant apologies for knocking her up at such a young age and fretting over his Unified. It got to a point where Beirani had to have Amateris herd him away so she could have time to herself, and in that time, she let herself be nervous and excited for her future.

Despite a few minor complications, Beirani laid her first clutch with little effort, and Avalyna and Glacello were born. They were feisty and needy hatchlings, and Beirani loved them with all her heart. They grew quickly, and she sent them off to school with nothing but pride and warmth. She did not know who they would grow up to be, only seeing the little ones she had brought into this world.

Six years later, a much more prepared Beirani laid Cryonius's egg, and by then things started to change. Rimos had suddenly started inserting himself in the lives of her two older kids, filling their heads with the same ideas that had made him so cruel, and despite the interception of Frozurne, it began to change them. Avalyna changed the most, her harmless energy and pride turning into arrogance and then cruelty, and she suddenly developed an enjoyment of causing pain towards others, with Glacello becoming her lackey. Her children became the very bullies who had tormented Beirani, and they stopped listening to her, even becoming cruel in the way only children could be.

Cryonius, however, was kind and friendly, ignoring the manipulation and teachings of his uncle and following in the steps of his parents. Despite being the younger and smaller sibling, he shared the same protectiveness of his father, standing up for his sibling's victims no matter how many times they beat him down, even when his heart grew heavy and tired of upholding said light. This would come to a head when Beirani learned that Rimos had been abusing and beating him, and while Frozurne dealt with his brother, she held her second son close and whispered apologies to him as she healed his wounds, feeling a deep, stabbing remorse for allowing her son to experience the cruelty she had grown up with. Rimos was exiled and Glacello and Avalyna were scolded and punished for this behavior, but it only seemed to make them worse, and after Rimos's death in 2997, executed for nearly getting his regiment wiped out with his glory-seeking and selfishness, Frozurne doubled down, even threatening exile towards his firstborns if the two didn't pull their shit together and see past their uncle's lies. Avalyna bit back twice as hard, while Glacello continued to act as her enabler, speaking cruel words while his sister enacted her violent whims.

This cruelty would continue with their future children, and every attempt to stop it short of actual corporal punishment would be met with resistance. It seemed that everyone but them was imperfect.

Scaldur, their fourth child, for her Fire and her desire to be a scholar. She had the fire of her grandmother and great-grandmother to protect her, but Beirani knew that she was also weary of the torment.

Beireius, their fifth, for his desire to be a Healer like his mother. Beirani kept him close to her, and trained him to defend himself with his natural knack for magic.

Frysure, their sixth, for being of Deep Blue Ice, an "impure" variant. He was young, and for that, his heart was not yet hardened, and she would often be the one to comfort him when the bullying from his older siblings got bad.

Cryonius got it the worst, both for standing up to them and for not being what Rimos claimed to be a "proper" clan dragon, empathetic of the clanless and kind to all, caring

little for status and riches. His mate, a Wind dragoness named Favona, was a welcome relief, for she was strong and firm, standing up to Glacello and Avalyna multiple times with her skill and ferocity in combat, and she was one of the few that could get the two to back down, however temporarily. Frozurne and Ullras both approved of this union regardless of Favona's element, and despite Avalyna and Glacello's complaints, the two were set to be unified in the future.

Things came to a head when Avalyna committed murder, seemingly killing a clanless dragoness in front of her Unified and daughter while Glacello helped. Cryonius and his mate Favona had stepped in to help, and in the scuffle, Cryonius had fought Avalyna and killed her when she could not be reasoned with. Burning Floe was forced to pull strings to keep Cryonius from being arrested for protecting civilians, and Glacello was disgraced but not exiled. When the dust settled, Beirani comforted her son, knowing that despite the grief in her heart for the daughter she had lost, he had done what his own father would have done.

Ambush and injury

In 3013, Beirani's regiment was ambushed while on-duty, betrayed by a member, and she was separated and grievously injured. Frozurne, having been ambushed and departed from the regiment, was able to reconvene with the soldiers who had been taken with him, and ward off the attackers. He and Amateris arrived just in time to ward off her attackers and return order to the Healers, but Beirani had taken the worst of the damage, suffering from terrible wounds and clinging to life. As she drifted in and out of consciousness, she was barely aware of the battle being won and the traitor being captured and bound. After returning from deployment, she was forced to temporarily take leave, bedridden and in pain.

Frozurne would stay with her through it all, but would always have a sad look in his eyes and these visits would be few and far between. She wondered then if it was because of her looks. Her scars were less grotesque than the injuries they had come from, but her looks had been permanently marred and despite the work of the Healers who had saved her, she suffered from pains and fatigue, and the trauma of the attack was harsh and unforgiving. It would be some time before she could recover fully, but she wanted to return to the 20th. She was tired of running away, and she would not

give up the purpose she had found for herself just because of her injuries and shaken resolve.

With the help of Amateris and Pelenis, the clan's Elder Healer, Beirani slowly crawled to recovery, regaining strength in her wounds and being given advice on how to confront the darkness that plagued her. Her Unified was often away, being a Commander and having to re-rally the 20th after such a devastating event, but he would be there when he could, watching in silent support. Even if she missed him being close to her, Beirani was glad that he had not abandoned her, and despite the berating of Amateris and those who were close to her, she never let them accuse him of being unfaithful or cruel in his intentions. She truly believed, in all her heart of hearts, that he was not acting out of malice or disgust, but guilt.

Present Day

Beirani has since recovered from her injuries, her scars nothing more than tissue that will fade with time. Her bond with Frozurne has been re-established, and the two were finally seen in public again after three years, attending the reclamation of the Abyssal Grave as a couple with their children. She has since returned to service, and has resumed her duties as a Healer with an assigned scribe to help her write notes and letters. The 20th is very happy to have her back.

Abilities

Element

Beirani doesn't feel the drive to go beyond Controlled for her element, mostly using it to treat burns. However, she can use it offensively if the situation arises, as it is very sturdy and capable of acting as a weak defensive shield in a pinch.

Magic

While she was not as elementally inclined, Beirani was a magically gifted child, and her high empathy and constant exposure to death only spurred her to further improve in her spellcasting, climbing to Practiced by the time she was 77.

Being a Healer, Beirani is good with healing magic, and intends to improve her skills over time. As Frozurne told her once, her paws are not meant to cause death, but to give life.

Physical

Beirani is small and slender, the typical build of Ice dragons, better suited for her role as a healer than anything combat-related. However, she was quick on her paws before her injury, and her tail is nothing to sneeze at if she aims right.

Relationships

Fluricus and Froseri+Half-Siblings

Beirani never understood why Froseri was so cold and cruel to her, and that hatred spread to Fluricus and their later broods of children. She is glad to be away from them, and does her best to not let them re-enter her thoughts, but they occasionally plague her dreams at night, and she doesn't like going out on her own anymore, afraid that they will attempt to harm her again. There is some bittersweet comfort in the memory of Burning Floe being willing to attack to defend her from them.

Kazkabar

Beirani has only met her sire in passing a handful of times over the years, and does not know of her connection to him. However, he has been helpful so far, aiding in keeping her safe when she's out in town, and while she doesn't fully see kindness in his gaze, she doesn't entirely see malice or disdain, either. She doesn't fully know what to make of him, but has decided that she can partially trust him, and that he is one of the less corrupt guards. However, she does not trust him entirely, and will remain distant from him for the rest of her days, never learning the truth about him and her heritage.

Frozurne

Beirani loves her husband dearly, as Frozurne is the one who changed her life for the better and helped her find the inner strength to continue living despite her hardships. She is not unaware of his initial pity for her when their betrothal was first suggested,

but she noticed his other feelings of remorse and genuine desire to connect with her, and that helped their romance bloom. If anyone can boss the intimidating and immovable Commander around, it's his petite wife.

While the two became distant in 3013, Beirani never blamed or hated Frozurne for his lack of will to see her in the state she was in, understanding that it was out of shame and guilt for not being able to prevent her injuries as opposed to disgust and shame at her for her appearance. This allowed for the two to reconcile quickly, and their love, loyalty and devotion to each other has never wavered once.

Cryonius

He is her little boy and always will be, and she is proud of how he stuck to his kindness and nobility after dealing with Rimos's cruelty for so long. She knows he also feels guilt for the death of Avalyna, and frequently tells him not to let it consume him. Cryonius was one of her main sources of companionship during her time being bed-ridden, and she encouraged him to let his feelings for Favona be known and to go through with his desire to unify with her.

Scaldur

She is proud of her daughter for pursuing her own path and being her own dragoness, and has high hopes for her future. She knows it will be difficult, but she has every faith that Scaldur will persevere and achieve what she wants.

Beireius

The two share a close bond, and Beirani frequently tutored Beireius in Healing magic when he showed more interest in it than his element. She's secretly a bit flattered that one of her kids wants to follow in her footsteps as a Healer instead of pursuing Frozurne's role in the military.

Frysure

Mother and son are close, and Beirani sees a lot of Frozurne in her youngest son. She knows he is trying his best to live up to such a heavy legacy, and does her best to give him a place to ease himself of such burdens.

Glacello

A loving relationship between mother and son soured by Glacello's descent into cruelty. In the present, she still loves him like a mother, but also knows that Glacello must face consequences and be punished for the pain he's caused others, especially since he's treated others the same way Beirani's family treated her back then. However, after learning of what he did to Marina and how he stood by and let Avalyna commit multiple desecrations of Burning Floe's code, she no longer sees him the same and there is a distance between them that neither wants to bridge.

Avalyna

She loved her daughter, but learning of all the cruel things Avalyna had done sickened and horrified her, tainting any innocent memories she might have. They were close when Avalyna was a child, but grew more distant as Beirani was forced to watch her daughter drift further away into bad habits and cruel ways of thinking despite her mother's best efforts to guide her down the right path. In the present, she can't help but mourn the loss of her daughter, but also feel deeply sickened by those who suffered like Beirani did because of Avalyna's cruel actions.

Ullras and Hestina

She appreciates their help in getting her away from her parents, and sees them as the parents she never had. She has a lot of respect for both of them and became like an assistant to Hestina after her wounds recovered to the point where she could walk again. Ullras's boistrousness and booming voice tend to startle her at times, but she knows he's harmless with her.

Ullreas and Flaranis

Beirani held and still holds a great deal of respect for the former Patriarch and Ambassador of Burning Floe, and was there to tend to them in their final years of life.

Amateris

They have been friends since their school days, and Amateris encouraged her to pursue her affinity in healing when she joined her and Frozurne in the 20th. The large Fire dragoness is also the only one who knew about Beirani's crush on Frozurne back when they were students at the temple, and maybe suggested the idea of the two

being possibly betrothed, something that played out well in the long run. The two have remained close friends, and Amateris tended to Beirani when she was injured (when she wasn't lecturing her brother to go visit his wife, of course).

[Geluros](#)

While Beirani never really got close to her Unified's youngest clutch brother, they get along well, and Geluros sometimes visits her to talk and catch her up with the going-ons of the clan. The two practice magic together on occasion, and Beirani often helps Geluros study healing magic when they're not too busy.

[Rimos](#)

Once a childhood school bully, Rimos was also interested in Beirani, and often made her uncomfortable when they were in the same room, even after she and Frozurne unified. She never liked him, and did her best to avoid him, although she was not afraid to stand her ground against him.

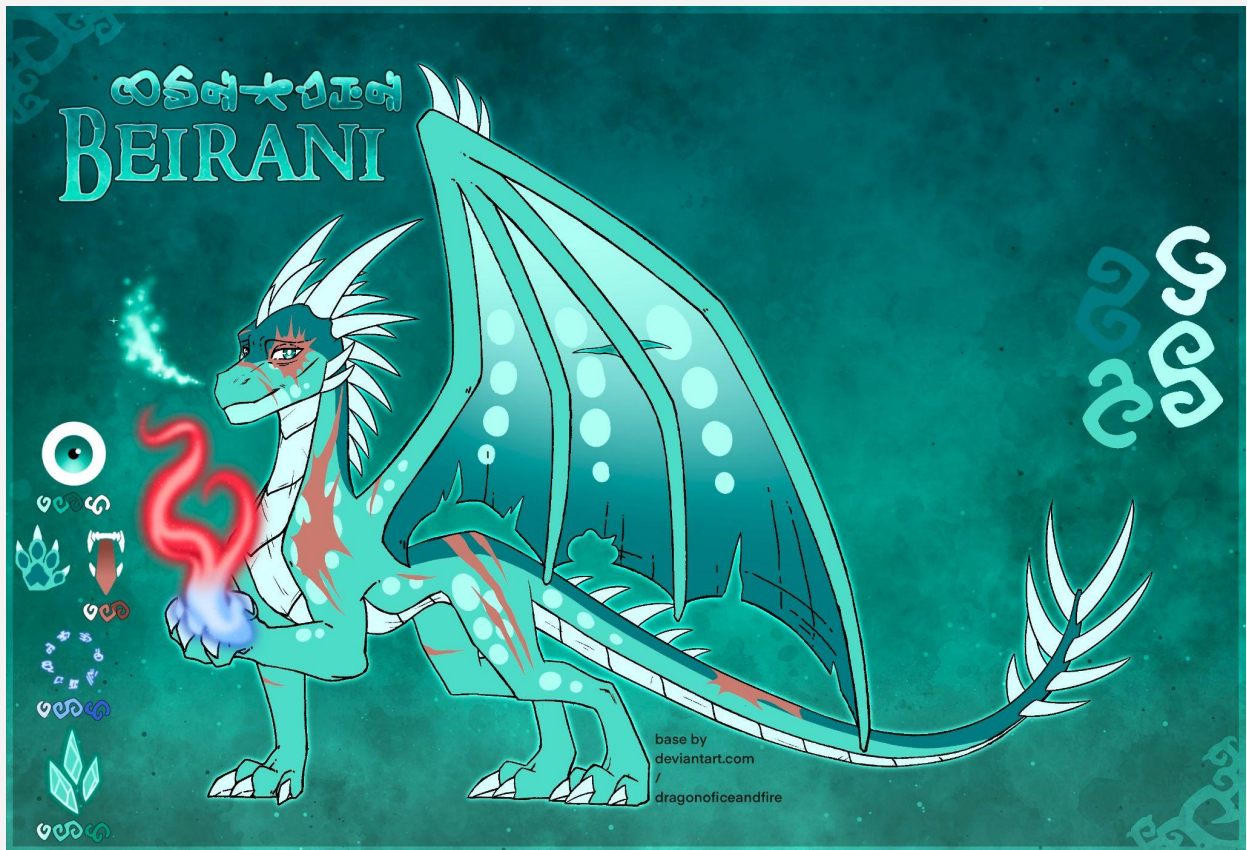
[Favona](#)

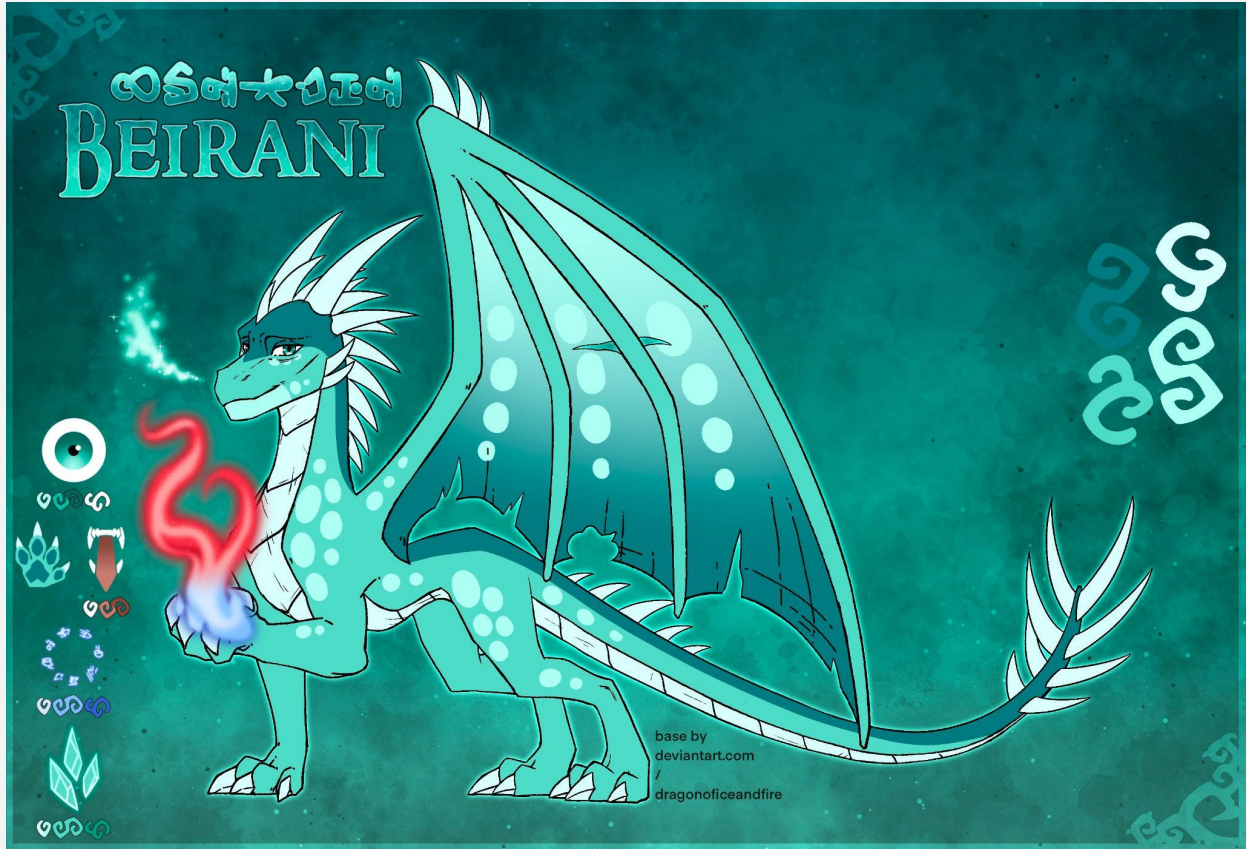
Trivia

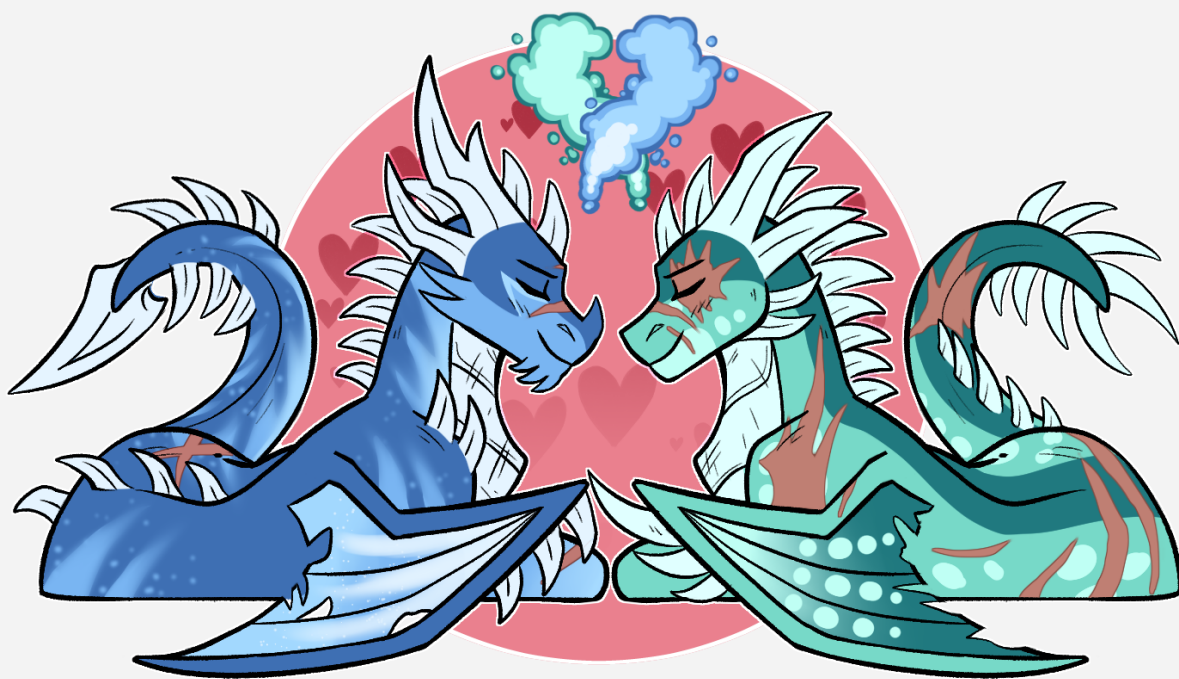
