- 2:45-2:55 Dressed, READY for practice, and in meeting spot for team
- 2:55-4:30 Team Practice Time
- STUDENT-ATHLETES MUST BE PICKED UP BY 4:40 P.M.

#### III. Rules of Conduct and Participation

#### A. Behavior Infractions (Disrespect toward other players/schools/etc.)

- 1<sup>st</sup> = Coach and Athlete Discussion
- 2<sup>nd</sup> = Player/Coach/Parent meeting w/signed behavior contract
- 3<sup>r d</sup> = Removal From Team

# B. Excused Absence (Excused from School, Homework Center, Doctor's Appt.)

- 1 Excused = Limited playing time
- 2 Excused = Limited playing time
- 3 Excused = Will not play in next game

#### C. Unexcused Absence (Ex: Unexcused from School,)

- 1 unexcused = Will not play in next game
- 2 unexcused =. Will not play next game + Parent contact
- 3 unexcused. = Removal from team

#### D. Suspensions/Detention (Repeated Classroom Behavior Issues)

- 1st Incident = Parent Contact w/behavior contract signed (Pleas note that student-athlete will NOT play in games until coach/admin/parent conference)
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Incident = Removal from team



#### E. Miscellaneous

• Forget Game Jersey = Player does NOT play

#### IV. Eligibility

At Cresthill Middle School students have the privilege of *choosing* to participate in a sport. When they make that decision they become a "CMS Student-Athlete".

Our student-athletes *will be held accountable* for both their character conduct as a CMS athlete (as outlined above) and with their performance in class as a student. Eligibility lists will come out every week based two criteria:

- 1. Work Habits Grades (Any student with 3+ missing assignments in a week will still be allowed to practice with their team but not play in games or meets.)
- 2. Character & Behavior Conduct (Both in and out of the classroom.)

#### V. JERSEYS/UNIFORMS

- Each person is responsible for their <u>assigned</u> practice/game uniforms
- Players who lose their <u>assigned</u> jerseys/uniforms will be charged a fee
- There will be NO exchanging of jerseys for practice and/or games

#### VI. TRANSPORTATION

With the new DCSD transportation policy for middle school athletics there will be NO buses for our student-athletes to use. Arrangements MUST be made for each of our student-athletes to get transportation to any away games or meets. With that said at CMS we want to be clear about expectations:

#### • AWAY GAMES/MEETS:

- o ALL student-athletes MUST be picked up in the front of CMS by 3:05 p.m. to give enough time to get to game or meet location
- o ALL student-athletes MUST have a parent sign them out with their son/daughter's respective coach at the end of the game or meet before they are allowed to leave. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- o It is a requirement that if anyone other than a student-athlete's parent or legal guardian is going to be taking them home, the parent or legal guardian must have direct communication with the CMS office and coach.

#### HOME GAMES/MEETS

o Athletes are not required to sign out at the end of home



#### games but MUST have transportation arranged.
