All Georgetown ISD K-12 students are provided access to a designated Chromebook for learning. The Chromebook is the property of Georgetown ISD. Students are expected to:

- Care for the Chromebook, and report any damage/loss or issues immediately.

- Demonstrate good digital citizenship and behave in a safe, legal, and ethical way while using district technology.
- Return the Chromebook at the end of each school year, or if they unenroll from GISD before the school year ends.

**Students and Parents, please read the expectations below and agree to each statement.**

	I will bring my Chromebook and charger to school every day, and I will be sure my Chromebook is charged every night. (High School only)
	I will keep the protective case on my Chromebook at all times, and I will treat my Chromebook with care to ensure that it does not get damaged. (e.g. Close the Chromebook before walking around with it, be careful with my backpack when my Chromebook is inside.)
	<p>If my Chromebook gets damaged or if it has technical issues, I will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• (Elementary, Middle School, GAP, Richarte) tell my teacher immediately.</li> <li>• (EVHS &amp; GHS) take my Chromebook to the campus Technology Office immediately to resolve the issue.</li> </ul> <p>If my Chromebook is lost or stolen, I will report it immediately.</p>
	I understand that this Chromebook is the property of Georgetown ISD. If the Chromebook or charger is broken or lost, I may be expected to pay to repair or replace it.
	I will not place stickers on my Chromebook or case, and I will not remove any Georgetown ISD labels from the Chromebook. I will not write on or intentionally damage/modify my Chromebook or case.
	<p>I will use this Chromebook responsibly for learning and school-related activities. 	I understand that Georgetown ISD's internet filter and email/file safety monitoring systems protect against inappropriate use of the Chromebook when I am at school and at home. I will not attempt to bypass the internet filter or safety monitoring systems.
	I will not let others use my Chromebook, and I will not share my login information (username or password) with others.
	I will return the same Chromebook, protective case, and charger that I was issued to my school at the end of the school year or if I unenroll from GISD before the end of the school year.

	<p>I have read the Georgetown ISD Responsible Use Policy for Students and/or watched the video overview at <a href="https://www.georgetownisd.org/departments/instructional-technology/digital-citizenship-responsible-use-policies">https://www.georgetownisd.org/departments/instructional-technology/digital-citizenship-responsible-use-policies</a> together with my child. I have discussed with my child what appropriate conduct looks like when using a Chromebook at school and at home. **Additional digital citizenship resources for parents and students are available at the bottom of the website listed above.</p>
	<p>I understand that Georgetown ISD complies with the Children's Internet Protection Act (CIPA) by using an internet filter and email/file safety monitoring systems. These protect against inappropriate use of the Chromebook and students' GISD accounts and prevent students from accessing inappropriate images and websites when students are logged into them at school and at home. Students should not attempt to bypass the internet filter or safety monitoring systems. I understand that no internet filtering software is completely effective, and some inappropriate content may be encountered. I will supervise my child while using their GISD Chromebook, and I will support my child in using the internet responsibly and safely.</p>
	<p>I understand that if my child does not use their Georgetown ISD device responsibly, their device or computer account could be taken away for a period of time, and/or they could receive disciplinary consequences. <i>(This is determined by the teacher and/or campus administration.)</i></p>
	<p>I understand if my child's GISD Chromebook, charger, or protective case is damaged or lost, or if my child does not return their GISD Chromebook, charger, or protective case at the end of the year or if they withdraw from GISD, I may be expected to pay to repair or replace these items, depending on the situation.</p> <p><b>The costs for repair and replacement are:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Replacement Dell Chromebook: \$465</li> <li>• Replacement Charger / Power Adapter: \$35</li> <li>• Replacement Case / Protective Cover: \$35</li> <li>• Screen Damage: \$140</li> <li>• Keyboard Damage: \$100</li> <li>• Broken Bezel (black plastic around screen): \$10</li> <li>• Broken Palm Rest (plastic around keyboard &amp; touchpad): \$40</li> <li>• Broken Left Hinge: \$100</li> <li>• Broken Right Hinge: \$100</li> </ul> <p><b>Accidental / Intentional Damage:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Warranty-covered Chromebook parts (due to accidental damage) may be replaced at no cost once per school year.</li> <li>• If the Chromebook is accidentally damaged a second time during the school year or if the accidental damage (at any time) is so extreme that it is declined warranty coverage, the student/parent <i>may</i> be expected to pay for repair/replacement.</li> <li>• If the damage to the Chromebook was caused intentionally, the student/parent <i>will</i> be expected to pay for repair/replacement.</li> <li>• If you are unable to afford these fees, you can make arrangements with the campus/district. Georgetown ISD offers online payment options, including paying over time.</li> </ul>
