Student Parking Policy and Procedure Form

In order to receive an MBHS parking permit, *YOU MUST DO THE FOLLOWING:*

1. Present a copy of your current **Driver's License**.
2. Upload this Policy & Procedure form signed and dated by both parent and student.
3. Complete the **On-Line Registration Google Form** on the [website](#).
4. Pay the appropriate fee according to your date of purchase (Pay Online (fee applicable), for cash or check made payable to MBHS go to A107).
 - **\$75.00** July 13, 2026 - March 12th 2027
 - **\$45.00** March 13th, 2027 - April 23th, 2027
 - **\$30.00** On or after April 24th, 2027

POLICIES & PROCEDURES

- _____ 1. Students are responsible for all information on the MBHS parking page found at the [website](#).
- _____ 2. All vehicles must be registered through the school office and the decal must be permanently affixed to the lower corner of the passenger windshield. **If a student desires to drive multiple vehicles during the school year, a permit must be purchased for each vehicle.**
- _____ 3. If a student desires to change vehicles mid-year (ex. purchase a new vehicle), he/she must register the new vehicle online, bring the remnants of the old decal to **A107**, and pay a \$10 replacement fee.
- _____ 4. In the case of a lost/stolen parking decal, students are responsible to *pay the full price* of a new permit.
- _____ 5. Vehicles, including motorcycles, must be parked in the student designated parking area. Any vehicle parked out of location, will be booted (**you are NOT subject to receiving a warning, you may be booted first time**). The boot removal fee is **\$40.00** (online fee applicable). See MBHS parking website for details.
- _____ 6. Students may not go to their vehicles during school without written permission from the school office.
- _____ 7. Students may not loiter in their vehicles before or after school.
- _____ 8. Students must drive no faster than 10 MPH through the campus.
- _____ 9. Students are held responsible for prohibited objects in their vehicle such as but not limited to tobacco, alcohol, drugs/medication of any kind, weapons, and shotgun shells/ bullets.
- _____ 10. **SEARCH AND SEIZURE:** Permission to park on the MBHS campus is granted subject to all rules and regulations of the school. By entering the parking lot, the person driving any vehicle is giving consent to a complete search of the vehicle by the school officials or police. If any person in the car other than the driver is the current custodian of the vehicle, consent to search is deemed given by the custodian also. The area of search will include, but not limited to, the entire driver and passenger compartments, trunk, undercarriage, and all containers therein, locked or unlocked.

The student understands that driving to school and parking on the McKinney Boyd High School campus is a privilege and not a right. The student will drive safely and responsibly and will not violate any school rules concerning vehicle parking or operation of vehicle on campus. The student further understands that school officials have the right to suspend or revoke the driving and/or parking privilege to, from and on campus for violation of registration, driving, or parking infractions set forth by the State of Texas, City of McKinney, McKinney I.S.D., and/or McKinney Boyd High School.
