Notice Of Return To Work

OCTOBER 24, 2022

On October 19, 2022, I announced that I would hand temporary reigns of the State Of Mesa To Lt. Governor Joshua Adamson, who has served since October 21, 2022, as Mesa's Acting Governor. During this time, I intended to ensure that all was well with my son Matt Paul, and return to my duties as Governor. Although, on October 23, 2022, plans changed following the death of my son.

As of October 24, 2022, I am here to announce that I will return to my duties as Governor after the funeral of Matt, which is slated to take place on October 27, 2022. I will return to my duties as Governor officially on October 29, 2022, and I will take back over as Governor. Acting Governor Adamson will return to his duties as Lt. Governor on this date as well. Effective October 29, 2022, I will return to my duties at noon on the aforementioned date.

As per State Regulation, I will turn in my formal "End Of Leave Of Absence" letter, which will authorize me to return, to the State Assembly. I will then assume full control of Mesa, and continue to move my administrative activities forward.

I will also direct my scheduling team to reschedule recently scheduled events and speeches. This will be done in the order in which the events were canceled and the dates on which such events were canceled.
