DATE: Sunday 8th January 2023

HOURS: Starts at 18:00 UTC

- > 9 races for each *divisions*. (more info below)
- > No elimination phases, winner takes all. Straight and to the point.
- *Tech only.

*In case of a 1st place tie in any divisions, tourney will be settled with a 1v1 Nitro duel, best of 3.

As mentioned, the tournament will be divided into three groups.

AMATEUR: Both for newfags and those who have been playing for a while who generally find themselves behind and struggle getting podium.

ADVANCED: For those with a firm grasp and good knowledge on both the game mechanics and maps, being able to take wins from the regular frontrunners but who are still lacking in consistency to be a constant contender for 1st.

EXPERT: Those who naturally find themselves winning races more often than not and being at the top of the pack despite tough competition, being confident in their own skills and in being perceived as a great player by others.

Both ADVANCED & EXPERT will play on randomized tracks from the list above, while the players in AMATEUR will race on 9 preselected maps, dubbed the Amateur Cup.

I ask you to sign up in the group that fits your current skill level the most.

Keyword: Be reasonable. There is no division that matters more than another. This is a system to organize as close as possible an evenly-matched competition for the most people. I would like the whole process to be done in good faith, but keep in mind that in some cases you won't necessarily be assigned to the division you've signed up for.

(Like, if someone with 4000 games played and who regularly has a KS score that goes up in the 2000s signs up for Amateur, I will obviously put them in Expert instead, but that goes without saying.)

If you know you're good sign up accordingly. If you know your limits or don't necessarily have the time to invest in a furry kart racer on steroids to keep up with the general level, it's fine to sign up for Amateur even if you've known the game for a long time.

Tournament will be streamed and commentated, look forward to being called a retard by other retards.

There is no cash prizes or anything, only bragging rights and $\underline{F} \cup \underline{N}$ to have on the line.

This is a good opportunity for many to play against other people of their level without the random nature of /v/eekend lobbies, both highly variable in the number of players and who's playing when.

NOTICE:

I cannot predict the amount of signups nor how many will sign up for each tier, so while I highly doubt there'll be any need to change or alter anything about the tourney, it's better to keep in mind the possibility in case of unforeseen circumstances.
