LIFE THREATENING ALLERGIES

Life threatening Allergens pose a significant risk to the health and safety of people affected by them. This policy and procedure outlines the responsibilities of the school to ensure that adequate care is taken to avoid allergic reactions and to provide appropriate treatment in the event that a reaction occurs.

It is the responsibility of the building principal in coordination with the school nurse to provide that appropriate safeguards to protect those with life threatening allergies from exposure to the problematic substance and to provide adequate training; appropriate planning; and sufficient communication to the school community about such allergies.
