Campbell County Area Technology Center is designed to give students in the surrounding districts of Bellevue, Campbell County, Dayton, Highlands, Bishop Brossart, and Pendleton County the opportunity to receive specialized training in a specific career pathway of their choice. Our goal is to prepare our students for success by working to acquire industry certifications and become career ready upon graduation.

All programs at the ATC, with the exception of Health Science, are two-year programs. When a student signs up for a program, they must make a two-year commitment to complete the program in order to get fully certified in their industry.

We also offer dual credit opportunities in most of our programs through our partnership with Gateway Community and Technical College. Current programs offering dual credit include: Auto Technology, Electricity, Fire Science, Health Sciences and Welding.
