Procedure:

Patient supine, head turned to left side, skin prepped and draped LA with 1% lignocaine

Previous right upper chest incision reopened, dissected down Porta Cath dissected out, removed and checked complete Manual compression to next entry site with hemostasis achieved Wound closed in layers using 3/O vicryl and 4/O nylon Dressing applied.
