# **Exec Reports**

#### Camp Director(s)

- Registration is lower than compared with same time this year
- Lots of time spent on Unirondack manual for future exec
- Waiting on several grant replies
- All staff hired, maybe more kitchen support
- Church visit in Plattsburg
- Higher number of campership applications

# Camp Manager(s)

- Spring registration review
- All trips have enough registrants to run
- All spring & fall rental spots filled
- Will be having a fall work weekend
- Camp opening went well, Dave Cushing had been going in every few weeks
- Spring cook dropped out, have coverage plan

#### **Exec Director**

- No major expenses
- All quarterly taxes up to date, yearly taxes upcoming
- Campership review, allocated almost full amount previously budget of \$14.5K
  - We currently have a shortfall between campership budget allocation and donations raised for camperships
- Requested campership amount is higher than budgeted (which is always the case), suggest move some \$\$ from endowment to cover budget campership shortfall & other camperships
  - Current fundraising for camperships could apply to next year's requests instead

Motion to withdraw \$10K from endowment to use towards camperships Emily motioned, Lynne seconded => Approved

#### Mission evaluation exercise

Use keywords in mission as inspiration, evaluation the following questions:

- As a board member, what part of this mission speaks to you most? Which part inspired you to serve on the board?
- As someone who attends camp or spends time at camp, do you see the most important visions of camp or parts of camp represented here?

Many shared opinions & insights.& debate

Open discussion on how to involve community

- Collect poll data from community via email, wordcloud compilation
- Could be single words (easier) or longer narrative
- Email followed by open house style meeting
- Introduce idea at camp to campers
- Include discussion group session during members weekend
- Consensus about introducing idea of mission assessment at members weekend, e.g. discussion group
- No vote planned for this year
- Ask campers to contribute to mission, small scale breakout discussions and/or graffiti wall (passive) feedback

Action: think about community involvement strategies, e.g.

- Newsletter blast for online feedback
- Introduce idea to campers
- Discussion topic for members weekend

# **Fundraising Discussion**

Sujata shared idea of fundraising calendar giveaway based on successful past experience

- Tickets sold for draws across a given month or interval
- Draw every day a winning prize
- Prizes would have to be available over a wide distance, e.g. virtual
