## **WFTC Lesson Slides Guide**

A guide for coaches to use when navigating the WFTC lessons slides. The slides are created as a substitute for the hard copy/electronic version of the updated curriculum. Coaches are be able to use these as a tool to teach any lesson and/or action activity.

Throughout the slides, there will be content provided in each note section. The note section is a critical to read as it has all of the following teaching points:

- 1. Coaching Tips
- 2. Action Steps
- 3. Read Alouds

The key provided below can be used as a guide to distinguish these 4 different parts of the curriculum.

(Parenthesis)	Coaching Tips	All content inside of parenthesis are coaching tips and tricks that all coaches should read and review before each lesson.  Example:  (To set the stage for your team and the season, it's critical to get everyone on the same page with your team values and expectations.)
Bullets	Action Steps	All content that is bulleted is an action step that the coach and/or students should perform.  Example:  • Ask students to answer the 'Discussion' question.
Italics	Read Alouds:	All content that is in <i>italics</i> should be read aloud to the students.  Example:  Last season we wrote and performed poems about ourselves, our neighborhoods, our communities, our passions, our interests, and our team.
