

KCRA RULES

The rules of Kings Crossing Recreation Association (KCRA) are necessary for the ongoing operation and maintenance of the recreational facilities and foremost, the safety of our members and guests. KCRA Rules are subject to change at any time by the KCRA Volunteer Board. Members agree their household and guests will follow the current rules maintained at www.joinkcra.com/pool-rules. Usage of the facilities is restricted to paid KCRA members and their guests. Membership is subject to cancellation at any time with review and decision by the KCRA Volunteer Board. See [FEES \(non-refundable\)](#) section below. Pool members may be asked to show a working pool key or identification to prove their membership is current.

****Please note:** KCRA does not have jurisdiction over civil misbehavior issues such as fighting and public drunkenness and other issues of that ilk. While we expect our members to follow the rules established by the KCRA Volunteer Board, KCRA provides an essentially unmonitored pool for the use of our paid members and their guests. Civil issues should be addressed by calling the proper authorities, in most cases it will be the Cobb County Police Department at 770-499-3911 or by dialing 911 for emergencies.

The pool gate key also opens the clubhouse entrance to the restrooms. Each membership is for a single household, for which one pool key is provided.

POOL

The KCRA swimming pool is maintained by volunteers for the use of KCRA members and member invited guests. During the pool season, regular pool hours are Monday through Friday, 10:00 AM to 10:00 PM. Exceptions to these hours may be necessary from time to time as determined by the KCRA Volunteer Board. Gates will be closed immediately after pool closing. No one is to enter the property or the pool after pool hours, unless a party is booked. **THIS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.**

EACH MONDAY NIGHT THE POOL WILL CLOSE AT 6 PM TO SHOCK AND CLEAN THE POOL.

All members have the responsibility to enforce all rules and regulations. Children under 16 years of age must be accompanied by and supervised by an adult member.

- No running on the pool level.
- No playing with the lifesaving equipment.
- Conduct that is not appropriate in a family setting will not be tolerated. This will include, but will not be limited to, drunkenness, use of foul language, fighting, nudity of any type, inappropriate attire, and other offensive or abusive conduct determined by the KCRA Volunteer Board to be unacceptable.
- No pets are allowed within the fenced pool area.
- Only one person at a time is allowed on the diving board and one jump per dive.

- Do not stand, sit, or hang on the pool rope.
- Absolutely NO GLASS is allowed on the pool level (this includes drink bottles, baby bottles, etc.).
- Food, cans, tab-tops, cigarette butts and other litter must be disposed of in the provided trash receptacles.
- No one under 21 years of age is allowed to drink alcoholic beverages.
- Food should only be eaten on the upper and lower decks, not on pool level cement areas.
- Members are expected to keep the pool area clean, and assist in enforcing the pool rules.
- No tossing or throwing hard balls, footballs, or other objects that may injure other members or guests.
- No diving in the shallow end of the pool.
- No chewing gum or chewing tobacco on the pool level
- Proper attire at all times – no thong bathing suits.
- Babies in diapers are required to wear special diapers for swimming.
- Fireworks are not permitted on any KCRA property or common areas.
- Members are to clean up after themselves.
- Smoking or vaping is prohibited throughout the pool and clubhouse areas except for in the designated smoking area, for those 21 and older.

GUESTS

Adult members (over 18 years of age) are permitted up to four (4) accompanied nonmember guests during normal week days and two (2) accompanied nonmember guests on Saturdays and Sundays. Unescorted members between the ages and 16 and 18 are limited to one (1) accompanied guest.

Parents are responsible for the behavior of their children. Guests may NOT be residents of Kings Crossing or any other solicited subdivision that have chosen not to join KCRA. KCRA reserves the right to maintain a safe adult/child ratio. NOTE: Large family groups are considered a party.

CLUBHOUSE & TENNIS COURTS

The KCRA clubhouse and tennis courts are closed and not available for use.

DECK/PARTY RENTAL

The two deck areas in front of the clubhouse windows can be reserved for a member-sponsored party for the day.

- Private use must be approved by a majority of the KCRA Volunteer Board of Directors prior to the event.

- The clubhouse must be reserved through the KCRA website at:

- \$60 Fee for up to 25 non-member guests
- Rentals are to adult KCRA members in good standing only.

The member sponsoring the party will be accountable for:

- Common courtesy towards other KCRA Members by keeping noise to a minimum.
- No unruly or obnoxious conduct. (The determination for unruly or obnoxious conduct will be determined by the KCRA Volunteer Board using a “reasonable person rule”: what a reasonable person would deem to be unruly or obnoxious.)
- No pets are allowed on the pool grounds.
- NO ALCOHOL IS TO BE SERVED TO ANYONE UNDER 21 YEARS OF AGE
- The deck(s) reserved will be cleaned and trash discarded in trash cans appropriately
