PLAY-BY-PLAY BROADCASTER

The Navs seek an undergraduate student to join the Media Team as Play-By-Play Broadcaster.

Successful candidate will work with the opposing team's student broadcaster and split play-by-play duties. Broadcasters will help coordinate Navigators Media Team operations.

Responsibilities:

- Broadcast all home and away regular season, postseason and exhibition games on ESPN+/Unbeaten/DAZN and other platforms to be determined (Play-by-play, color, interviews, etc.)
- Assist to manage press box operations and broadcast equipment

GRAPHIC DESIGN

GAME ENTERTAINMENT

The Navs seek an undergraduate student to join the Media Team as a Game Entertainment intern. Successful candidate will be responsible for playing music and working with the Public Address Announcer on other game presentation elements at home games.

Responsibilities:

- Play all music, sound effects, etc., played throughout the ballpark
- Turn on and off stadium sound equipment before and after games and events
- Managing stadium sound levels
- Manage database of player walk-up music
