Dear IB Parents/Guardians and Students,

It is time to register for the May 2026 International Baccalaureate exams. It may seem early, but the IB assessments include more than just a single exam in May; all IB subjects include at least one internal assessment component (which could be a paper, a portfolio, an oral commentary, a laboratory experiment, etc.) that will take place earlier in the school year. For the sake of global consistency, these assessments will not only be scored by Agoura High School educators, but our marks will also be verified by qualified IB examiners across the globe. With over one million IB students worldwide, you can imagine that this is a large undertaking

Why take IB exams? The rigor of IB is well known, and the extra work for our students and teachers is considerable. We would not embark on this endeavor as educators if we were not confident that the IB experience is indeed a meaningful one for students. As a result of tremendous effort and in-depth exploration and reflection in their subject area, our IB students leave AHS well-prepared for college and a 21st-century world. They have the skills they will need, as well as the self-discipline required to complete major projects independently. Typical feedback from IB alumni tells us that taking IB classes makes the transition into college comfortable, and many earn university degrees in less time as a result of the credits they have earned from IB.

How can students earn university credit through IB? At most colleges and universities, Higher Level (HL) scores of 5, 6, or 7 translate into credit. For the UC System, students can earn units for scores of 5 or better on designated individual Higher Level exams. In addition to credits earned for individual courses, students completing the IB diploma with a score of 30 or above will also receive 6 quarter units total toward their UC undergraduate degree. Check with your college(s) of interest to determine their specific policies regarding IB credit.

For the 2026 IB exams, students at Agoura High School will be registering online. This registration will take a few minutes and can be completed from any computer with internet access.

This year each IB exam costs \$128.00. There is an administrative fee of \$20 per student.

Online Exam registration will begin on Monday, Oct 6, 2025 at 8:00 AM and end on Friday, Oct 31, 2025 at 11:59 PM. In order to register, students need to visit [www.TotalRegistration.net/IB/050003](http://www.TotalRegistration.net/IB/050003) . Please note, this is a different link from the AP Exam Registration.

To complete registration, students must answer all of the required questions. Registration is not complete until students have received the confirmation page that is provided at the end. We recommend saving this confirmation to your computer. We know that parents may desire to register their students for exams. We strongly recommend that parents and students are both present while registering to ensure that the correct exams are ordered.

- Mon, Oct 6, 2025 at 8:00 AM - Registration Begins
- Saturday, Oct 25, 2025 at 11:59 PM - Registrations and payments after this date will incur a \$25 late fee per registration.
- Friday, Oct 31, 2025 at 11:59 PM - Registration Ends
- Monday, Nov 3, 2025 at 11:59 PM - Registrations that have not been paid for will be canceled and exams will not be ordered.
- Mon, Jan 1, 2025 - Last day to cancel an exam with a cancellation fee of \$75.00.

## AHS IB EXTERNAL EXAM INFORMATION

### MAY 2026

1. The IB External Exam is the culmination of the classroom experience. External Exams occur in May (a schedule of exams is available on the AHS IB page). All students will be required to complete all *internal* course assessments and other assignments prescribed by individual teacher(s) as part of their course grade. **Students who choose not to sit for the External Exam(s), will be assigned a comparable assessment by the teacher in order to receive weighted credit for the course.**
2. Although the possibility of college credit should not be the primary reason for sitting for an IB exam, it is possible that a particular college or university *may* indeed offer credit and/or other benefits for passing an IB exam. **It is the responsibility of the student and his/her family to contact Admissions Departments of particular colleges and universities in order to determine the benefits of examining in one or more IB courses.** (See below for results information).
3. **Exam fees are determined by IBO.**
4. **Candidates will not be registered for exams until they have completed registration through Total Registration and submitted payment** (or financial arrangements have been arranged with the IB Testing Coordinator). **The first deadline for IB Exam Registration is October 25, 2025.** Students who wish to register after the Oct 25 deadline will incur a \$25 late fee. Registration closes on Total Registration on October 31, 2025. Please see the IB Coordinator if you miss this deadline. The deadline for exam refunds with a \$75 fee is Jan 1, 2026.

### IB COURSE RESULTS:

1. **Candidates' results are issued on July 6 on candidates.ibo.org.** In order to obtain examination results, candidates must use their unique alphanumeric username and PIN issued by the coordinator.
2. **IB will not discuss results with candidates or their parents.** The IB Diploma Program Coordinator is the intermediary for any communication with IBO. If a candidate's grade is lower than expected, there is an "enquiry upon results service" whereby the IB Coordinator can order a copy of the candidate's assessment and marking, and, if desired, can request a reexamination in the subject area (to occur in November following the examination session). There are fees associated with enquires upon results and reexamination services. **All requests for enquiries and reexamination services must be made through the IB Coordinator by Sep 1.**
3. A university or college may require evidence of a candidate's results directly from IBO. On request, a transcript of results for a candidate will be sent directly to the institution in electronic or paper format. **Candidates are responsible for contacting the IB Coordinator by June 1 in order to request to have results sent. Candidates are able to request results sent to one university or admissions center free of charge** (if made prior to June 1). Requests must include the candidate's name, the name of the university or admissions center, and any other information the university requires on the transcript (application numbers, student identification numbers, etc). It is the candidate's responsibility to determine what information the university or admissions center requires on the transcript. **Juniors testing in one or more IB subject areas should request transcripts in their Senior year.**

**You'll be asked the following questions as part of the registration process:**

- Know what type of candidate you are:
  - Anticipated - junior working toward your IB Diploma
  - Career Program - N/A do not select
  - Course - junior or senior taking one or more IB courses (not pursuing the diploma)
  - Diploma - senior taking the full IB diploma
  - Retake - N/A do not select
- Questions that might need clarification:
  - 1st language - what language did you learn to speak 1st
  - 1st nationality - what is the country of your primary citizenship
  - English proficiency - **write High, Medium, or Low**
  - Testing accommodations - **do you have a 504 or IEP that allows for accommodations?**  
**If so, select YES**
- Enter your parent/guardian information
- Select the courses you are registering for
- Enter payment information
- You're done!
