We Need Photos!

We need photos of school events, classroom events, children working in the classroom, field trips, and anything else having to do with the school. Photos from ALL classrooms and ALL school events are always welcome.

The Student Photographers will be busy taking pictures but it takes a while for them to learn and they are only able to take pictures on site - not during field trips or Carnaval (for example). You, the parents and guardians, are able to take pictures during field trips as well as during class time. All of these pictures are welcome and needed.

What Are They Used For?

Many photos are used for the yearbook. Some are also used for Back to School Nights, end of year gifts for teachers and classrooms, magnet fairs, and the school website. Names of children are never included in or with photos (except, of course, in the yearbook).

What if I Said "No" on the Media Consent Form?

Photos of all children are included in the yearbook. Children who have a "No" on their Media Consent Form are not included in photos that we use for things other than the yearbook, such as the school website or district magnet school newsletter.

What If I Don't Have a Camera? May I Borrow One?

Yes! We have digital cameras available for checkout for school related events. Please remember that some of the loveliest photos are of children working in the classroom. Come to the Media Center to find out how you can borrow a camera.

How Can I Get Them To You?

There are many ways to give us photos:

 Upload them to one of our DropBoxes: We have a folder for each grade level, classroom, as well as one for events and "other". You will not be able to see what's inside the folder, but you will be able to upload your pictures:

- CD, SD card, flash drive: You can give us a CD, flash drive, or an SD card and we will copy the photos and give them back to you. You can find us in the Media Center or leave an envelope with the CD, flash drive, or SD card in the front office and they will get it to us. We will return them to your child.
- Email: You can email them to Margaret at mbecker@smfcsd.net. You can also email Margaret a link to a website where you have posted photos (e.g. SmugMug, Shutterfly, flickr, Picasa, DropBox). Please know, however, that some of these services (e.g. Shutterfly) will not let you select multiple pictures for download we have to do it one-by-one and for this reason we are not likely to use those pictures.
- Come on in: You can also bring your camera in to Margaret in the Media Center and she will download the photos and give your camera back to you. You can give us prints and we will scan them and give them back to you. It is always best to email her first (mbecker@smfcsd.net) to set up an appropriate time for you to come in.
