

Hide the coins and have them use the compass. Say go more north, go south etc. (That would probably end up being in front of you behind to left etc. Or if old enough use actual directions)

Hide the coins in places that rhyme with the colors.
Red (Bed)
Orange (Hinge)
Yellow (Hello, Jello)
Green (Bean, Clean)
Blue (Shoe)
Purple (Circle, Turtle)

Just turn the coins upside down and match them to the colors
