Call to Order

Mr. Gregory Cava, Chairman, of the Shepaug Building Committee, called the E-Meeting to order on Monday, October 4, 2021 at 10:02 am.

Approval of Minutes:

MOTION: made by Jay Hubelbank, seconded Tony Bedini, to adopt the minutes of August 14, 2021

VOTE: Unanimous (Motion Passes 6-0)

Chairman's Report:

Chairman Cava referenced the spreadsheet and email from Tim Chan sent this morning. It was noted that the frozen water pipe issue had been added. John Kuck had stated he was on the campus and noticed the under flashing at Bldg. F had not been completed. Tim Chan thought it had been completed and there was a walk through with Don and Steve. Tim will check with Steve. Don O'Leary confirmed that he had not walked the campus with Scope.

Facility Manager Report:

Don O'Leary spoke on the water pipe issue. He had spoken with Tim, who will be making a proposal for work needed. Discussion as to location of the pipes.

Critical Path:

Only one item was mentioned and that had been the frozen water pipes.

Construction Manager's Report:

Tim Chan referred to the spreadsheet and briefly reviewed the items and dates listed. The replacement panels are on site. Work on the finishing room ventilation is expected to begin

this Friday. This is a Professional Development Day for staff which means no students will be in the building as work is being done.

It was reported that very little of the contingency money has been used by O&G.

Architectural Report:

Brennan White spoke on the upper soccer field. It appeared that the grass was growing in nicely but once mowed, dead spots were seen. Chairman Cava stated he had asked the landscaper about the spots and it was said to be a disease. Brennan noted he was not part of that conversation and had not been made aware of the issue. Tim added to the conversation saying he had spoken to Steve and this is called Summer Patch and would need \$900 of fertilizer. It was suggested to use Poly On. Don O'Leary added that unless more seed was put down, there would be no growth. Reseeding would need to be done in the spring. Superintendent Bennett stated that the field is usable but is being limited.

It was noted that slip seeding and replacement plants still needs to be done. Tim Chan stated that the plants are out of warranty. Mark Jeffko stated he will follow up.

MOTION: made by Valerie Andersen, seconded by Tony Bedini, to accept the landscaping with the understanding slip seeding would be done as well as the replacement of the dead plants.
