

A brief history:

The original school on site, Confluence School, first opened a classroom in 1921. Later, Rocky Mountain House School was added in 1949 (our current west wing), along with Rocky Elementary School in 1956 (our current east wing). The school proceeded through a large modernization project in 1989 that saw the addition of the amazing library and music room spaces. In 2000, the school was renamed École Rocky Elementary School to reflect the vibrant French Immersion program that started in 1986 and also runs within the dual track school. 100 years after the first classroom opened, we are proud to celebrate the thousands of students and staff that have furthered their education on site.


