Camp Guidelines

1. If the siren sounds, immediately go to the Dining Hall, where we will get a head count.

3. In the event of a medical problem, please contact the Scout Leader or Senior Patrol Leader at your station.
4. Please fill out the survey to help us improve next year's program. Drop off in survey box at Dining Hall.
5. Scoutmasters will be responsible for returning all mattresses at their site to the storage location, but please help them as you can.
6. Please don't leave fires unattended at any time.
7. Please follow the Buddy System at all times.

Host Troop's Responsibilities

Purpose: Provide a positive camping experience for Webelos Dens by making contact with and guiding the WEBELOS Dens camping in your campsite.

Plan:

- 1)** We're asking each Host Troop to designate and introduce one adult as the Helpful Point Person for the WEBELOS and WEBELOS Adults staying in their site.
 - Senior Patrol Leaders and Troop Leaders should make themselves available to answer questions throughout the day that WEBELOS Leaders may have (sharing cell phone numbers is encouraged).
- 2)** Instruct WEBELOS Den Leaders on expectations for their Scouts who are using the tent cabins.
 - Cabins need to be swept out on Sunday morning.
 - Dens will be responsible for any damages incurred to tent cabins.
 - Most common damages are tears in screens.
- 3)** SPL or ASM needs to walk through all tent cabins used by each den before that den leaves the campsite.
- 4)** SPL/SM please check-out utilizing the camp check-out list notifying the staff.
- 5)** Help ensure above Camp Guidelines are followed.

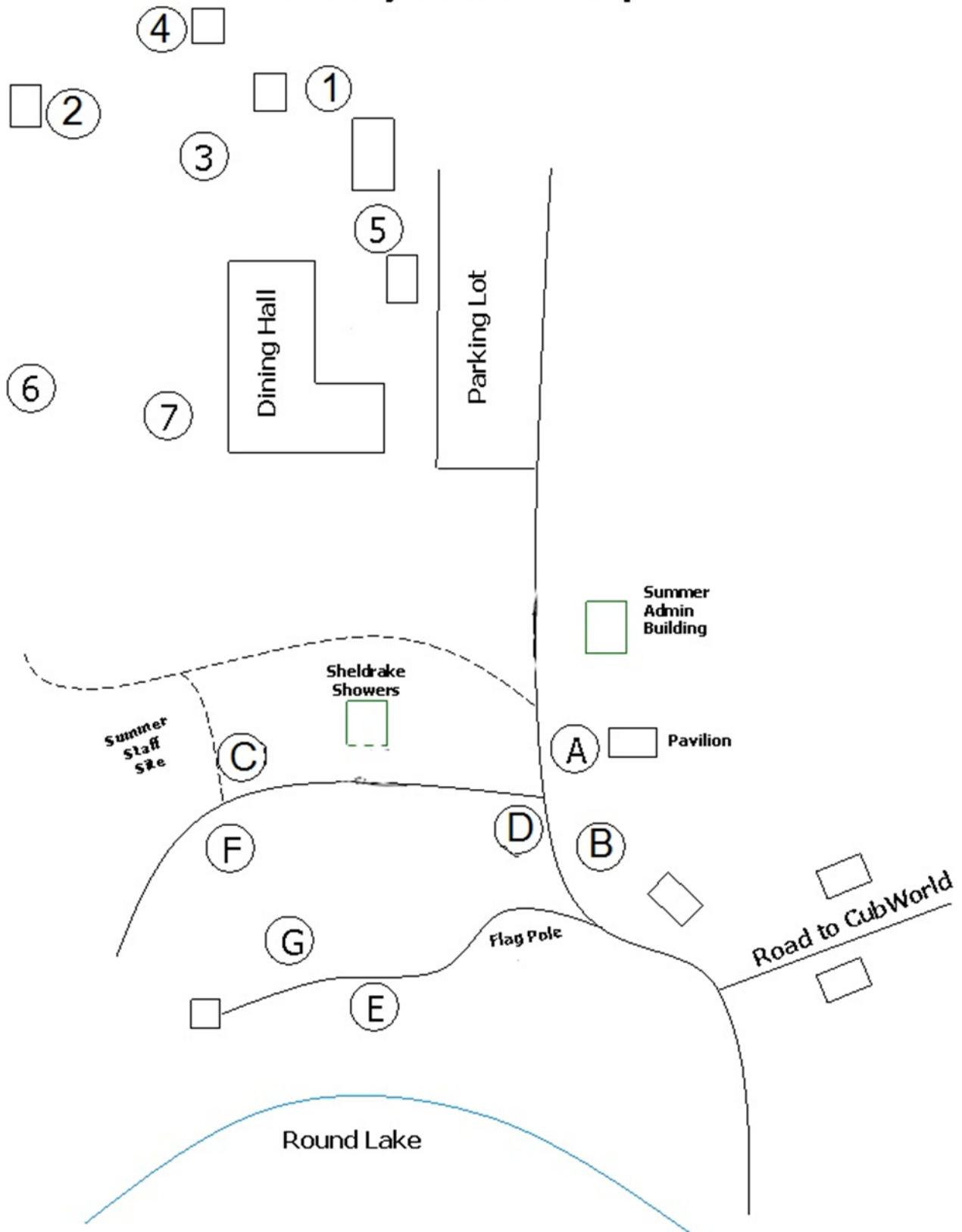

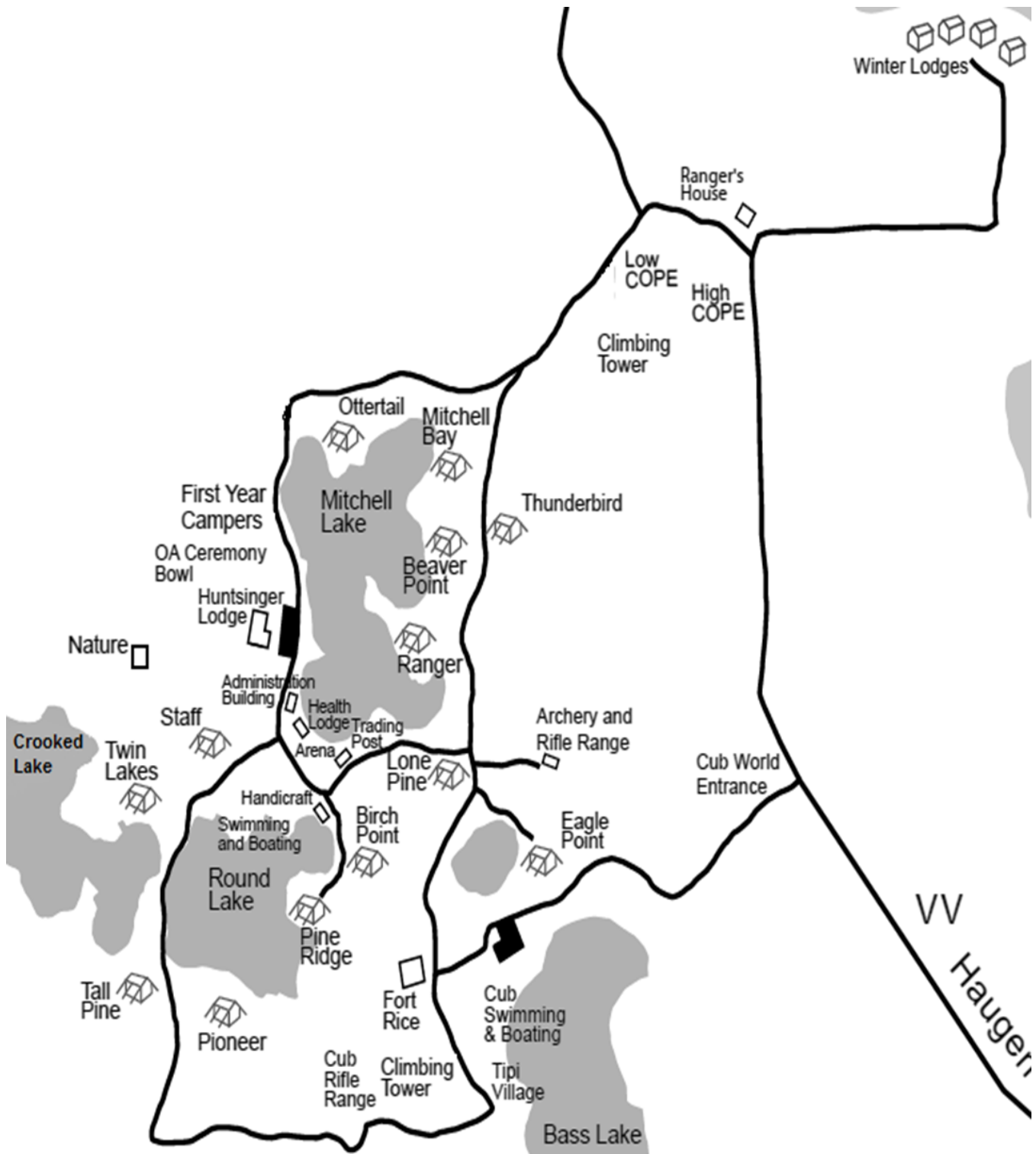
