Re: Spring 2025 election information for residents

Wisconsin's Spring 2025 election is now just weeks away on Tuesday, April 1. As it is with every election, the goal of the League of Women Voters of Dane County is for all eligible voters to be able to register, cast a ballot and have their vote counted.

This letter contains **information we hope you will share with your residents.** This information can be included in welcome packets, emails and newsletters; featured on your website for residents, and/or posted onsite in common areas.

Key dates for the April 1 general election are:

Mar 4 Last day to establish residency for April 1

Election

Mar 11 City Clerks begin mailing absentee ballots to voters with requests on file

Mar 12 Last day to register online or by mail

Mar 18 - 30 Early Voting (In-Person Absentee)

No registration after Friday, Mar 28

Mar 27 Last day to request an absentee ballot

Apr 1 Election Day
