Manuscript Article Writing Instructions

Journal of Toque & Apron (JT&A) does not limit the number of authors but it is recommended to have up to three authors. Manuscripts should be written in English (USA) and submitted through [the official JT&A website](#). During the submission period, manuscripts will be processed:

- Plagiarism or similarity checking with a limit of 20%;
- Checking the suitability of manuscript articles with [the objectives and scope of JT&A](#), and;
- Author Data Requirement Checking.

Any non-compliance with these three points will result in the manuscript being rejected and returned to all authors via email and through Whatsapp/Telegram chat notifications.

Manuscript articles are written based on one of the word count categories; 4000 words or 5000 words, which excludes Keywords and References. Although there is no general rule on the word count of each section of the manuscript, JT&A recommends following the word count of each section of the manuscript, with reference to the following rules:

The writing of manuscript articles refers to the structure, format, and content specified in this template.

Article Title

Introduction

This section contains explanations about; study background, reasons for selecting literature, and study contributions.

The background contains an explanation of the importance of the topic in the study, with paragraph content about the exposure of the identity of the reviewed literature. The literature that can be the object of study is the latest scientific papers - at least the last five years - either in the form of research articles or scientific books related to:

- Culinary arts study,
- Culinary business, and/or;
- Culinary tourism.

For scientific papers in the form of research articles are those indexed by Science and Technology Index (SINTA), SCOPUS, and/or Web of Science (WOS). For scientific papers in the form of books, they are widely published and listed in Google Books. The reason for the selection of literature refers to:

- Issues of lack of or inadequate assessment of the topic of study,
- Controversial issues of lack of or misunderstanding related to the topic of study,
- The issue of the limitations of the study related to the study topic, or;
- The issue of the importance of studying a specific problem contained in the topic of study,

which can be chosen in part or in whole. The contribution of the study contains a description of the expected contribution of knowledge to higher education institutions and/or professions in the field of culinary arts either referring to the realm; culinary arts studies, culinary business, and/or culinary tourism.

This section contains a detailed presentation of the discussion of the results of the literature review

This section can be divided into several sub-sections according to the needs of the review

Conclusion

This section contains a brief presentation of conclusions about the practical implications of the results of the literature review.

Conflict of Interest Statement

This section is mandatory for manuscripts with more than one author. If there is no conflict of interest, rewrite the following statement format: "There is no conflict of interest between the authors related to the writing, submission, review, and publication of this manuscript article either in the context of each author's role and/or finances, and the authors submit the submission, review, and publication process to the Journal of Toque & Apron".

References

The writing of this section follows the format of the seventh edition of [the American Psychological Association Style \(APA Style\)](#). This section can be written without using reference management software with these conditions. For the use of reference management software, although there is a References feature installed in [Microsoft Office Word](#), it is recommended to use [Mendeley](#) or [Zotero](#) to follow the latest edition of the reference format.
