The House consists of 98 elected officials who serve two-year terms. Every legislative district in Washington has two representatives who live in and represent the district. Voters elect the 98 representatives in every even-numbered year's election. Representatives serve on several committees that meet frequently during the legislative session to discuss proposed laws and hear input from the public.

Education and Qualifications: Jamie declared his candidacy as a Democrat on 5/6/2026. Jamie is a horticultural retail worker and a student finishing up his degree at UW Tacoma, majoring in urban studies and minoring in politics. Jamie was born in Scotland, moving with his mom and siblings to the United States around 2008. During his time at UW, he founded the Immigrant Defense Coalition, an organization that educates and empowers people to resist governmental overreach. His focus if elected would be on affordable housing, cheaper gas and free medical, dental, and childcare.
