Accessing eBooks from Destiny Discover

- 1. Click Search Our Online Catalog under the Library tab on the <u>Bryant website</u>, and log in.
- 2. On the <u>Destiny Discover</u> homepage, type in a title, author, or topic in the search bar at the top. Narrow your search using the Filter on the top-right of your results (under the search bar). The Format filter will allow you to select print or digital books. Once you click on a title you will have the option to open and/or check out the book.

Accessing Sora (NYC's Citywide Digital Collection)

- 1. Sign into Sora with your DOE account.
- 2. Use the menu on the top-right for settings and to add other library systems to your search (e.g. Queens Library, NYPL, etc.).
- 3. Use Preferences at the top-left to filter your results.
