QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED:

- Passionate about mountain biking and mountain bike trails
- Very intimate knowledge of the Whistler valley trail network (WORCA maintained trails)
- Fit and able to travel through rugged terrain, listen to and adhere to safety protocols, and respect smart work practices in a wilderness environment
- Trail building and/or trail maintenance experience
- Enjoy working outside and able to work in all weather conditions
- Capable of heavy physical labour
- Able to follow directions and work within a team environment
- Occupational First Aid Level 3 (or 80 hour equivalent) is an asset

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Maintain existing trails, structures, and features on WORCA maintained trails
- Build new trails, structures and features to WORCA trail standards
- Prepare and help facilitate WORCA Volunteer trail days
- Ensure proper signage is appropriately placed and maintained according to WORCA/RMOW standards
- Use of all hand tools required in the performance of daily activities shovels, pulaskis, picks,

clippers, hand saws, and other trail-specific tools

- Follow the occupational health and safety regulations provided by WORCA, particularly in regard to the specialized work and sanitation conditions as necessitated by COVID-19
- Prompt return to work after breaks from work. Any food or supplies required for breaks will be taken to the worksite.
- Willingly follow the directions as given by assigned supervisors and managers
- Additional duties as required

EQUIPMENT AND PERSONAL APPAREL:

Employee to provide:

- Personal transportation to the designated job site start and finish location on each work-day (to be pre-determined by Lead Trail Builder in advance)
- Safe closed toe work footwear; preferably with a steel toe, ankle protection, waterproof/resistant, and good lugged high traction sole
- Long pants and long sleeve shirt (to be worn at all times)
- Rainwear and cool/cold weather clothing as may be required

WORCA to provide:

- Work gloves as required (2 pairs provided at outset and replaced as needed).
- Safety eyewear
- Any other Personal Protective Equipment as required by the job at hand and as determined by the Lead Trail Builder or supervising trail crew member.
