"Sorry, usually eevee trainers have a weird family that necessitates showing off the eeveelutions. Except Gary, weirdly..."

"Oh, that's weird. Say, you wanna meet my four kimono-clad tea ceremony sisters at our eastern palatial estate?"

"...sure."

Yep so after Sakura dips her hair in ink and gets ready for the ceremony (I do love the pokeball hairpins) Brock does his thing with her sisters who must be older, I guess.

No of course this place is strictly non-regional! Can't have other ethnicities in your show about travelling to different lands, right Fiorello Cappucino? "Italia!"

Then this sister throws her audience back in their seats with her astounding arrangement skills.

YOU ALL HAVE THE SAME-ISH FACE. YOUR WHOLE FAMILY HAS TORIYAMA SYNDROME. Mind you, when you think about it that's a cutting satire on societal norms, the liquid nature of beauty standards and how humans always find ways to discriminate but I'm... guessing that MIGHT not be intentional.

And for once I'm glad to see team rocket as we still have nothing much in terms of a plot twerpside. They of course have no respect for tradition (though you'd think James would have at least some sense of decorum) and get the most uncomfortable group stare possible.

Oh geez, my autistic brain can't stand it! So...much... second-hand embarrassment... Luckily the rockets are all "screw it" and get rumbled by AAHHHH WHO ARE YOUUU?

Oh wait, \*slap\* of course, sakura's eevee will evolve during the course of this battle, making espeon the centre of attention, that makes sense! It's even during the day with high friendship! Carry on then.

Ah, well of course we need to establish their bond further, so instead we'll get a showcase of just how strong the sisters and their eeveelutions are-

Okay, so after the rockets blast off we get a VERY abrupt cut to misty and sakura relating, almost as if Team rocket was stuffed in to pad out time!

\*you must be a trainer too\*

"Hey, you're right! What tipped you off?"

"Oh it's mainly the way you hold yourself, the turns of phrase you use... the battle in front of my face kind of cemented it, though."

"Oh yeah, it's almost like that battle was stuffed in for time without thought for continuity, huh?"

Then after a weird kind of ad for the show within a show that's technically an ad...

We actually get a cool idea of having Sakura join the party as a newbie trainer, pre-empting May by a good 80 episodes! I wonder if it'll pan out! Misty runs the idea by the rest of the gang and WHOA Brock what happened to your nose! I guess Misty's yank from earlier did more damage than I thought, No wonder she usually goes for the ear!

No, ya gotta use take down, THAT's what launches team rocket, remember? But eevee is caught, the twerps trap the others...

Then umbreon is rolled out - hey, a fast ball WHY WASN'T IT A MOON BALL LIGHTNING IS FAST UMBREON ARE DARK SWAP BALLS DANGIT - and the rockets are blasted off properly to make way for the fight between jolteon and PIKACHU COME ON

### **Thoughts**

#### **UUGGGHH WHATTA MESSSSS...**

This episode had great animation and cool locations and neat ideas but it was just so disappointing on all those fronts. The animation by the usually top tier A team of Asada and iwane had its moments but for the most part it failed to deliver. The battles were too short and relied too much on "hit it very hard". Some of it was by necessity for time but I know ONE SEQUENCE IN PARTICULAR that could have been easily cut to give the battles the room they needed to breathe.

The locations and characters were cool as well... Until they took a back seat to the recycled conflict and aforementioned bland battles. Imagine if each sister battled in full regalia and had moves and strats based on their roles in tea ceremony? It would have even served double duty of showing Sakura that there was value in staying behind and learning from them!

And speaking of that, UUUGH that ending! Like I said, there's absolutely nothing wrong with wanting to be more independent and self reliant before setting out on a journey, but that was never established as an issue! Sakura SAID she knew she was inexperienced, that's why she wanted to learn from the twerps! I guess "getting cold feet is valid" is also a decent message, but again, it just seems to come out of nowhere and is explained poorly in my eyes. My view is also somewhat biased as I thought the idea was great to have sakura stick around to have a new dynamic to explore in the party. She didn't have to STAY, but just have a Todd situation where she hangs out for maybe five episodes or heck, wait until they have to pass by ecruteak again and have her decide to stay with her sisters then!

I want to give this a rock so much, but I can't dock points too much for missed opportunities, that's like saying a movie sucks because my fanfiction is better. But even standing on its own it's dull and annoying, so that's a poke ball. And WHERE WAS FREAKING ESPEON-

#### Trivia

Now here's a bizarre case of 4kids being LESS convoluted in their localisation than the GAMES! Shocking I know but the kimono sisters in this episode not only have the same names as the Japanese version, but in turn the same names as in the games... in Japan.

Let me put it this way, the english version of the Gold and Silver GAMES... changed the names of the kimono girls... to OTHER JAPANESE NAMES. Not 4kids. The GAMES.

In the western release of Gold and Silver, Sumomo became Kuni, Satsuki became Miki, Koume became Naoko, Tamao became Zuki and weirdest of all, SAKURA, one of the most western friendly japanese names of all time thanks to Cardcaptors... was changed to Sayo.

\*kenan\* WHY?

This is DOUBLE confusing as in pokemon Go, a way you can choose how your eevee evolves is by nicknaming them either Sakura or Tamao they evolve into Espeon or Umbreon, respectively. The JAPANESE names.

So bravo 4kids. You did this one good. Golf clap.

They actually did another somewhat justified if still confusing change during Jolteon's battle. See, here they use thunder wave to deflect thunderbolt. Kind of bogus, but in japanese they use... Zap cannon? Zap cannon. Like, of course they should have used light screen or something instead of thunder wave but ZAP CANNON?
